#### Update Treasurer's Report – Tom Osberg

- \$33,128.60 in checking; \$504.37 in savings
- Paid \$5,500 from savings to School District for mat
- Program advertising update
  - Received \$950 from advertisers; Programs cost \$544 to produce; Advertising profit \$406
  - Waiting for 3 advertisers to pay; Coborn's backed out after program went to print; absorbed the cost
- All expenses are paid to date

#### Coaches Report

- Update on Wrestlers – everyone is getting healthy
- Thanks to: Youth and Middle School for the mat; Karen for keeping up with communications; Tom for the fantastic job on the program.
- Youth program donated \$500 to the High School for working at the Youth Tournament
- Kiffmeyer Dual update – Elks needed to see this level of competition; whether we attend again will depend on the weekend and whether we are able to schedule another tournament in December.
- Future Mat purchases should not be in December – Winter is a difficult time for the cure process to occur (7 days on each side)
