TODAY'S GAME

The U.S. Men's National Team faces Finland in its second-tolast game of the preliminary round at the 2014 International Ice Hockey Federation Men's World Championship. The U.S. and Finland are tied for the fourth and final playoff spot in Group B. Russia (15) is in first place, while Latvia (9) and Belarus (9) are tied for second.

ALL-TIME vs. FINLAND

Team USA is 20-1-2-27-8 (W-OTW-OTL-L-T) against Finland in the IIHF Men's World Championship. The nations have met four times over the last two tournaments. In 2013, **Craig Smith** had a hat trick in a 4-1 preliminary round win, and followed that up with a goal and an assist as Team USA earned a 3-2 shootout victory in the bronze-medal game. In 2012, Team USA posted a 5-0 win in the preliminary round before Finland won by a 3-2 count in the quarterfinals.

An all-time, game-by-game series history is on page two.

YOUTHFUL JONES EXCELS

Defenseman **Seth Jones** has recorded six points (2-4) in the last two games to become the top scoring defenseman in the tournament (2-5=7). Jones' seven points also lead Team USA. The youngest American player (19), Jones scored two goals, including the overtime game winner, and added an assist against Kazakhstan. One day prior, Jones racked up three assists versus Latvia. Jones also leads Team USA in ice time, averaging 24 minutes, 37 seconds per game.

FIRST LINE PRODUCTION

The line of **Brock Nelson**, **Tyler Johnson** and **Craig Smith** has contributed eight goals, including five on the power play, and eight assists. Smith is tied for the team lead with three goals and is second with six points (3-3). He had a goal and an assist in each of the last two games. Nelson is tied with Smith for the goals lead (3) and has five points (3-2). Johnson has a 2-3=5 scoring line and is Team USA's top faceoff man, winning 57% of his draws.

TROUBA, ABDELKADER OUT VS. FINLAND

Team USA will be without two of its top players today against Finland. After missing the game versus Kazakhstan, defenseman **Jacob Trouba** returned home for precautionary reasons and will not return to the championship. He had two goals and an assist in four games, while averaging more than 23 minutes of ice time per game.

U.S. captain **Justin Abdelkader** is suspended for today's game following an IIHF Disciplinary Panel decision. Whistled for kneeing against Kazakhstan Friday, Abdelkader was further penalized for the knee-on-knee hit. He will return vs. Germany Tuesday.

IIHF GOOD TO GAUDREAU

Johnny Gaudreau has tallied three assists over the last two games, improving his tournament scoring line to 1-5=6. Against Kazakhstan, his second helper of the day led to the overtime, game winner. Gaudreau also tallied a game-high three points (1-2) against Belarus. At the 2013 IIHF World Junior Championship, Gaudreau led the tournament with seven goals and finished with nine points as Team USA won the gold medal.

SCORING DEPTH

Team USA ranks third in the tournament with 19 goals, an average of 3.8 tallies per game average. Twelve Americans have lit the lamp. Sixteen players have at least a point.

Against Kazakhstan, three of four goals were scored by defensemen -- **Seth Jones** (2), **Matt Donovan**. The blue line corps has 7-12=19 totals.

FIRST TIMERS FIND SUCCESS

Fifteen players have made their U.S. Men's National Team debuts during the tournament. Four of Team USA's top five scorers are competing in their first IIHF Men's World Championship, including **Seth Jones** (2-5=7), **Johnny Gaudreau** (1-5=6), **Brock Nelson** (2-3=5) and **Tyler Johnson** (2-3=5).

POWER PLAY PROWESS

The U.S. power play has converted 28% (8-for-29) of its power-play chances, good for third-best in the championship. The eight power-play goals are the most by any team. Team USA has been 2-for-7 in each of the last two games. Brock Nelson and Craig Smith have two man-advantage markers apiece.

PENALTY KILL PROFICIENCY

Team USA is 16-for-19 on the penalty kill. The 84% success rate is tied for sixth in the tournament. Only Germany (11) has faced fewer shorthanded situations than the U.S.

CAPTAINS AMERICA

Justin Abdelkader is serving as captain of the 2014 U.S. National Team. He is playing in his second Men's World Championship (2012).

Craig Smith, who is playing on his fourth straight U.S. Men's National Team, will serve as a full-time alternate captain. **Colin McDonald** and **Tim Stapleton** will split the role of Team USA's second alternate captain. McDonald will wear an 'A' when the U.S. wears white, and Stapleton will don an 'A' when the U.S. wears blue.

2013 MEN'S WORLDS RECAP

The 2013 U.S. Men's National Team (6-1-0-3, W-OTW-OTL-L) captured the bronze medal in Stockholm, Sweden, earning Team USA's first medal since 2004. After placing third in the preliminary round, the U.S. topped Russia, 8-3, in the quarterfinals before falling to Switzerland, 3-0, in the semifinals. Team USA bounced back to defeat Finland, 3-2, in a shootout highlighted by **Alex Galchenyuk**'s heroics. Overall, captain **Paul Stastny** led the team with seven goals and 15 points. **Craig Smith** notched a team-best 10 assists and had 14 points. Goalie **John Gibson** had a 3-1-0-1 record, 1.56 GAA, .951 SV% and one shutout.

2013 RETURNEES

Jeff Petry, Craig Smith, Tim Stapleton and Jacob Trouba were members of the 2013 U.S. Men's National Team that won the bronze medal in Stockholm. Sweden, by topping Finland, 3-2, in a shootout. Smith led Team USA with 10 assists, while his 14 points were second-best on the squad. Stapleton chipped in two goals and three assists. Trouba had a goal and two helpers. Petry did not record a point.

MEN'S WORLDS VETERANS

Nine players are IIHF Men's World Championship veterans. Of particular note are Craig Smith, who has played in a team-high 21 Men's World Championship games, and **Tim** Thomas, who is participating in his seventh tournament. Only Eric Weinrich (9) and Mark Johnson (8) have played for more U.S. Men's National Teams than Thomas.

TRANSLATING JUNIOR SUCCESS

Eleven players have won gold medals at the IIHF World Junior Championship, while four more have earned bronze.

In 2013, Gaudreau, McCabe and Trouba were on the media all-star team. Trouba was also named Best Defenseman by the directorate.

Additionally, Jimmy Hayes was on the 2009 U.S. National Junior Team.

DEVELOPING CHAMPIONS

Team USA has medaled in 11 consecutive IIHF Men's Under-18 World Championships and 12 out of 13 tournaments (gold-8, silver-3, bronze-1). Seven players on the 2014 U.S. Men's National Team have contributed to that success.

- Drew Shore earned gold in 2009.
- · Jimmy Haves earned silver in 2007.

CALDER TROPHY FINALIST

Tyler Johnson is one of three finalists for the NHL's Calder Memorial Trophy in 2013-14. He tallied 24 goals for the Tampa Bay Lightning, tying for most by a rookie this season. Johnson's 50 points (24-26) ranked third among firstyear NHL players. He would be the first American to claim the Calder Trophy since Patrick Kane in 2007-08.

Johnson tallied a pair of assists for Team USA in its 6-1 win vs. Belarus on Friday.

BROTHERS HAYES

Brothers **Jimmy** (24) and **Kevin** (22) Hayes are teammates for just the second time of their careers. The duo from Dorchester, Mass., played at Boston College together during the 2010-11 season. Jimmy represented Team USA at the 2007 IIHF Men's Under-18 World Championship (silver medal) and 2009 IIHF World Junior Championship, while Kevin is making is Team USA debut. Furthermore, they are cousins of for-2010 (gold): Matt Donovan, Jake mer NHLers Keith Tkachuk and Tom Fitzgerald.

TEAM USA COACHING STAFF

Peter Laviolette is serving as head coach of the U.S. Men's National Team for the third time. Previously, he led Team USA at the 2004 and 2005 IIHF Men's World Championships, leading the team to a bronze medal in 2004.

He was the head coach of the 2006 U.S. Olympic Men's Ice Hockey Team in Torino, Italy. He then served as an assistant coach for the 2014 U.S. Olympic Men's Ice Hockey Team in Sochi, Russia.

Also, he served as an assistant coach for the United States during the 2004 World Cup of Hockey, where he helped Team USA to the semifinals.

Joe Sacco is serving as an assis-

tant coach of the U.S. Men's National Team for the third time (2009, 2010).

In 2013, Sacco was head coach of the U.S. squad that won the bronze medal at the IIHF Men's World Championship in Stockholm, Sweden, and Helsinki, Finland.

Phil Housley is serving as an assistant coach for the U.S. Men's National Team for the second year in a row and third time overall. Last year, he helped Team USA win the bronze medal in Stockholm, Sweden, and Helsinki Finland. He was also an assistant in 2011.

In 2013, Housley was head coach of the U.S. National Junior Team that won the gold medal at the IIHF World Junior Championship in Ufa, Russia.

He was an assistant coach for the U.S. National Junior Teams in 2007 and 2011, helping each team collect a bronze medal.

Don Granato is an assistant coach for the U.S. Men's National Team for the first time.

He has been a head coach at USA Hockey's National Team Development Program since the 2011-12 season, having led the U.S. National Under-17 Team in 2011-12 and 2013-14, and the U.S. National Under-18 Team in 2012-13.


He will serve as an assistant coach for the 2015 U.S. National Junior Team.

MANAGEMENT TEAM

The 2014 U.S. Men's National Team is under the direction of the U.S. Men's National Team Advisory Group, including NHL general managers Stan Bowman (Chicago), Paul Holmgren (Philadelphia), Dean Lombardi (Los Angeles), David Poile (Nashville), Ray Shero (Pittsburgh) and Dale Tallon (Florida); Calgary Flames president of hockey operations Brian Burke; Pittsburgh Penguins pro scout Don Waddell; and Jim Johannson, USA Hockey's assistant executive director for hockey operations. Tom Kurvers, senior advisor to the general manager of the Tampa Bay Lightning, joins the group in 2014. The U.S. Men's National Team Advisory Group was formed in February of 2007 to assist USA Hockey with the selection of players and staff of U.S. Men's National Teams, including the Olympic Team.


