Parents Standards of Conduct

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in this year's Bulldog Youth Sports Football team by following the Code of Ethics listed below:

- 2. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for **ALL** board members, players, and coaches at every game and practice.
- 3. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child and all participating children, **<u>AHEAD</u>** of any personal desire.
- 4. I will support the Board, Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Team Moms working with my child as to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
- 5. I will treat, and I will insist my child treats, others on the Team, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Team Parents, Board Members, Officials, and Fans with respect.
- 6. Above all, I will remember that my child is learning and that the point of any game, practice, and competition is to **HAVE FUN!**
- 7. The following actions will not be exhibited during any practice, game, or event:
 - a. Undesirable behavior (fighting, smoking, drinking, drugs, etc.)
 - b. Failure to perform volunteer duties
 - c. Undesirable language
 - d. Any act or deed that harms the reputation of the community or team/squad.
 - e. Disrespect shown to any Team, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Team Moms, Board Members, or others.
- 8. I understand that School District #118 does not allow any smoking or drinking on any of the school grounds. Any violations of this rule will cause our organization's privileges to be revoked from the use of any school properties.
- 9. I understand that there are consequences given if I choose not to follow the above codes.
