The ratings formula awards teams points for defeating A or B+ teams and takes points away for losing to teams rated B or lower. That is why it is virtually impossible for a team to be ranked in the top 32 that does not regularly play A or B+ teams. The number of meets won - - or overall record - - is relevant only if achieved against strong competition. If you coach a team that we rated "B" and you want the opportunity to move up in the rankings because you think your team can compete at that level, consider registering as a "B+" team for the 2014-2015 season. On a related issue, Wisconsin-based teams that are invited to the Wisconsin State Invitational Championship Tournament, but decline, miss an opportunity to show that they can compete at the highest level and therefore the opportunity to move up in the rankings.

Note also Paragraph B-11 in League rules: "Teams that fail to play at least three meets during the 2013-2014 season, or who declined to play in the most recent LCT and offer no legitimate excuse for doing so, will not be included in this season's year-end rankings of top 32 teams at each grade level." There are at least one or two teams at each grade level that would otherwise have been ranked below, but are not, because of Rule B-11. We have, however, made exceptions for teams that played in at least two strong meets last season and have made a more significant commitment to the League for the 2014-2015 season.

Teams that dropped in the rankings from the season before shouldn't necessarily feel that they have regressed. At each grade level, we added several teams for the 2013-2014 season. Many of these teams were rated at the B+ level or higher, making it more difficult to make the top 32. Also, since one or more teams at each grade level decline their invitation to attend the LCT because of conflicts, some teams not listed in this original top 32 ranking will likely be included in the final LCT field at most grade levels.
