These policies include, but are not limited to, Conflict of Interest, Confidentiality, Safesport, Locker Room, and Zero Tolerance. Each member of the CAHA Board of Directors, any Officer of the Corporation and anyone holding a position appointed by the CAHA Board of Directors acknowledge that they are aware of the USA Hockey Policies and agree to abide by those policies in performing their duties and responsibilities with CAHA.

With regard to any actual or potential conflict of interest each member of the CAHA Board of Directors, any Officer and anyone holding a position appointed by the CAHA Board of Directors agrees to disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest, as defined in the USA Hockey Conflict of Interest Policy and the CAHA Conflict of Interest Policy, and to refrain from voting on a matter before the Board of Directors involving a conflict of interest. Examples may include working for a rink or hockey association, holding an investment or ownership in a hockey-related enterprise, being a coach, volunteer, or team manager for a hockey association, and more.
