Go to www.usahockey.com and click on the online registration button:



This will bring them to the online registration section:



They click on Ice Players & Coaches which then brings you to:



You will notice that they have to click the box that indicates that they are currently 18 years of age or older. The reason this is important (beside the fact that you can't go any further without clicking this!) is because online registration also includes the waiver of liability.

The next step will be to select a season. As of May 1, there will be a second option and they will be able to also select the 2007-08 season. Participants who are trying out now should be covered by their current USA Hockey membership. Your instructions would simply tell them to go online after May 1 and complete their registration for the upcoming season.



The process works well for families who are registering multiple participants. You can see below the options that appear on the screen:





Next you get to the summary screen where you can either continue to checkout or cycle back and register another participant



I won't continue on with more pictures of the process as it is pretty standard for any of you familiar with purchasing something online with your credit card. When the payment part of the procedure is complete, a confirmation is emailed directly to the person who completed the registration. The confirmation has a barcode on it as well as a confirmation code. At this point USA Hockey knows all of the information that it needs with this registration except if it is a player or a coach and what organization the registration should be related to. So far your local organization has had no involvement in the process. Keep in mind what your local registrar had to do before as I step you through what they have to do now.

Once an online registration is complete, the participant either prints and brings the confirmation they receive to their first practice, or simply forwards the email to your local registrar (bpease@maine.rr.com). DYH would encourage you to forward the email as soon as you have completed the online registration.
