7. Committee Reports

Facilities (Pat)

Pat shared that J&D Sales (Scott & Tracy Trippler) donated 50% of the cost of the fans on the North Rink. In addition, they also sent representatives to the rink to provide ideas on how to use best utilize the new fans. The fans are used to help with the dripping we have been seeing over the last couple of years in the north rink. THANK YOU!

- **Locker Room D**
Locker Room D is almost completed. We still need to complete the shelves. We will move the shelves from the current locker room D to the new one. For now, teams should not be using this locker room yet. We are still doing well on the budget.
- **Zamboni Wrap**
The check has been sent and we will accept the wrap as-is.
- **Security System**
Trevor is still working with the company to schedule this work.
- **Update on Dehumidification**
Pat, Trevor, and Steve met with Market & Johnson and they are proposing to be our project manager to scope the work, get in contact with other companies to perform the work, and oversee the project. We intend to move forward with a gas-fired unit for the south rink. We will be requesting proposals in the near future.
- **Zamboni Room**
It is clear that we need to have two Zamboni's able to run effectively. In order to do so Pat is suggesting that we retrofit the Zamboni room to be able to be able to handle two Zambonis. A detailed plan will be developed and presented for consideration in next year's capital budget.

Finance/Administration (Randy)

- **Plowing Contract**
The first time we were plowed out was by an individual that gave us a quote that day and did not charge us for it. THANK YOU! The second time the lot was plowed by an individual that had a kid on the Bantam team and he sent us a bill for it. The third time was done by Chippewa Valley Excavating (Damien Prince). This was the company that was awarded the plowing contract for the 2013-2014 season. Bob will follow-up with him to address the backside fire lane and clearing in front of the doors.

- **General Discussion on Behavior at Rink**
There was discussion about some of the issues that we typically encounter during the heart of the hockey season
 - Teams should be using the designated dryland areas (North Rink). Teams should not be running laps around the rink and definitely should stay away from the slick areas near the Zamboni room doors.
 - People should avoid using the areas that are closed off as indicated by signage (Zamboni areas) for safety and liability concerns.
 - Kids that are not skating on the ice should be supervised by an adult and not running wild around the rink.
 - Kids should be wearing helmet/gloves (as noted by the signage) in the shooting cage.
 - Kids should not be shooting pucks or bouncing pucks/balls against walls in dryland areas. This should only be being done in the shooting cage.
 - Kids should stay out of the equipment area and not be playing with medicine balls in an unsupervised manner.
 - We have lost some items from the rink (namely the Shop Vac) so PLEASE do not remove equipment from the premises without prior notification and approval.

Special Events (Rod)

- **Update on BeerFest**
The tickets have been printed. We will request a more detailed update for the January meeting.
- **Ice Bowl**

Brian Anderson is going to contact Kris Johnson to see if we can lead a down-sized version (Just Friday-night Corporate Night) for this year's Ice Bowl. If so, we will be looking for volunteers to assist.

- Country/RockFest

We have gotten a good volunteer response already and we are looking to open it up to the association after the first of the year.

On-Ice (Scott)

- Mite Hockey Boards

We are going to set them up this weekend for the first time.

- Tournament Update

We are doing relatively well though have a disappointing turnout at both the U12 and U14 levels.

- Outdoor Rink Plans

The outdoor rink is open. The biggest issue is that we are seeing kids (and adults) skating without helmets. All parents are asked to help monitor this situation and when necessary explain to skaters that if there are sticks and pucks on the ice a helmet is required.
