- 1723 Timing: It is recommended that all dual meets be timed with automatic timing equipment or with minimum of two timers per lane. It is recommended that all Conference Tournament events be run with an electronic timing system.
- 1724 Diving Judges: Three diving judges for each dual meet and if possible, five or seven judges for championship meets.
