2320 Regulations/Schedules

- Volleyball shall be governed by The National Federation of State High School Associations rules, with Wisconsin adaptations, as well as WIAA rules and regulations.
- The ball recommended for play shall be an eighteen panel colored NFHS approved ball. The <u>HOST</u> school will provide all properly inflated balls for pre-game warm-ups.
- The <u>HOST</u> school shall report match results from <u>ALL LEVELS</u> to Divine Savior Holy Angels by phone (414) 616-2809, email <u>seegers-braunp@dsha.info</u> or fax (414) 466-0590 by the morning following the match.
- Athletic Directors will provide rosters with all three teams on one page to each school prior to the first Conference match.
- Levels of play will be JV2, JV, and Varsity. Once rosters are set, a player may move up or down a level for Conference or Tournament play on a particular day. However, a player may only dress and play in one match per day at any level unless a team has low numbers. If a team has low numbers, a player may play in the allowed 6 sets per day accoreding to WIAA rules. However, a player may only play in ONE Conference Tournament. JV2 teams will adhere to the maximum number of games as set by the WIAA for Freshmen teams.
- All volleyball schedules shall be drawn by the Athletic Director in charge of Volleyball and approved by the Athletic Directors. If both schools agree

to move a match from the original date on the schedule, that will be allowed. No match may be played later than the last date on the approved schedule.

The JV and JV2 Conference Tournaments shall be run at facilities with 4 courts to allow for our 8 teams to play a bracketed tournament. Currently teams with four courts: Brookfield Central, Brookfield East, Germantown (in 2023).

2330 Contest Guidelines

- All JV2/JV matches will begin at 5:30 PM. If Marquette is hosting two JV2 matches, they will be played at 4:00 PM followed by the JV at 5:30 PM. All Varsity matches will begin at 7:00 PM.
- JV2 and JV matches will be played simultaneously prior to the Varsity match.
- 2333 JV2 and JV will play two out of three sets (rally scoring), with the winner of 2 of the 3 sets determining the winner of the match. The third set is guaranteed and will be played to 15.

 Varsity will play three out of five sets (rally scoring) to 25 points to determine the match winner. If a fifth set is necessary to determine a match winner, the fifth set will be played to 15 points with no cap.
- There will be a minimum twenty-minute warm-up period prior to each match. Warm-up procedures will be six (6) minutes of shared ball handling, seven (7) minutes of home team alone on court, seven (7) minutes of visitors alone on court.
- An adult or qualified student shall be the official scorer for each Conference match at all levels. The visiting team scorer may also be present at the score table.
- At the beginning of the match, the starters will go to their respective endline for introductions. They shall remain there until directed by the officials to shake hands at the beginning of the match. They shall not shake hands as their names are called. They should simply step forward.

- Conference standings will be decided on the basis of match play. One point will be awarded for each match victory. The team with the most wins at the end of the regular season will be declared the Conference dual meet champion.
- In the event of a tie, the championship will be shared. Each team will receive an award.
- A Conference Championship bars and individual awards shall be made in accordance with the Award By-Laws (470). The Conference will award one (1) Championship bar to the Dual meet Champions and fifteen (15) team certificates, one (1) Championship bar to the Conference Tournament Champions and fifteen (15) team certificates.

All-Conference awards will include eight (8) gold and eight (8) silver medals and one (1) Athlete of the Year plaque. Players receiving Honorable Mention will receive a certificate.

2350 All-Conference Selection

- All-Conference selection will take place the night of the Conference Volleyball meeting at the end of the season.
- Coaches will nominate players from their team worthy of First Team selection. Each coach will provide CONFERENCE statistics for each player nominated, as well as a picture for identification. Each coach will speak about each player nominated.
- A secret ballot will be taken from the list of nominated players for first team. Each coach will vote for eight (8) players. Coaches may not vote for their own players.
- The eight (8) players receiving the highest number of votes will constitute the First Team All-Conference. In case of a tie, another secret ballot will be cast between players involved in the tie. Coaches may not vote for their own players. The loser of the tie will automatically be placed on the Second team.
- Coaches will nominate players from their team worthy of Second Team selection and Honorable Mention. Conference statistics should be available for each individual nominee.
- A secret ballot will be taken from the list to fill out the remaining positions for the eight (8) positions on the Second Team. Coaches may not vote for their own players.

- A player must receive at least one vote to be considered for Honorable Mention. Upon completion of the voting for All-Conference, a coach may appeal to have one more vote taken with regard to a player who was already nominated, but did not receive a vote for Honorable Mention. The player may be placed on Honorable Mention if he receives at least 4 votes (if we have 8 teams in the Conference) or 3 votes (if we have 7 teams in the Conference). A coach may not vote for their own player.
- "Player of the Year" will be vote on my the coaches from the players receiving First Team All-Conference selection. Coaches may not vote for their own players. Coaches will have three tries to break ties for "Player of the Year." If they are unable to break the tie, the Athletic Directors will break the tie and determine the "Player of the Year."
