- 1. Zac Dockter
 - Park/Rec plan: [handout]. Current plan still works, but 2014 update. Study finding: need to improve facilities currently have. Short term [5 yr] & long term plan. Funding: city move cell tower fees [Park Improvement Fund] for capitol expenditures: grant opportunities. CGAA can participate. Projects work faster if work together, Park HS, too. All adopted by city. Indoor artificial turf: primary need, proposal included. Need direction from Association re: partnership, lease options, etc. Example: Ice rink time vs. turf time. Know the need is there. 115K\$, city would front cost, but need a lease agreement on backside [250 hrs commitment]... school may want in... Q: how quickly get in? Q: around March 1st annually. Q: re-ice? A: not until fall. Q: tournaments? A: maybe not as many, lost the AAA tournaments. Q:continue to do other activities? A: no, this would be separate. Smoot: really like the idea. Q: hours.. 8-8 weekneds, 5-9 weekdays Mar 1 mid April? A: all day availibility. Would be nice to have some "public" time, but CGAA resp for rentals. Q: cost? A: \$100/hour. Picked a number. Q: need to know by? A: soon, by June.

Dan Smoot: Positive Coaching Alliance [handout] 3-year program

- Four hands-on workshop sessions to provide better experience for players.
- Proposing bringing in the organization & standardize our coaching experience w/in CGAA. Prior Lake ran the program & is successful.
- Will love to take the lead w/in CGAA & make better than surrounding communities
- Highly qualified personnel to lead program; could offer 2 double coaching to cover seasons; 2ndary 2-1 course or get parents involved in "life lessons" and winning on the fields.
- Q: How early? A: Like to start as early as July. Board [leadership] session, then coach session, then incorporate spring sports. Football board 100% behind.
- Q: 300 count? Where that came? A: average board = 8-10 people, plus coach number, then add some carry-over.
- Q: Mandatory? A: football, yes. All other? Maybe not. Q: Park HS? A: would love to introduce & invite PHS to attend.
- Q: Other programs similar: Impact coaching/Comparable programs, how does it compare? A: that's a free, more a 1-time shot for couple hours. This program is progressive courses w/online resources, daily emails, newsletters that support, etc. This is progressive over time.
- Q: payment? A: annual basis. One-year = \$4950; Two-year and Three-year price structure. Looking at a longer term, advise the 3-year option to incorporate into culture.
- Q: what is not bad for CGAA Gambling involvement... good public publicity & could afford [in July]... at eoyear, if not happy, then what...? Break into installments? Want to see Park HS on same page, too.
- Baseball: yes; Brad Strom & Bollback willing to put some funds toward it.
- Can host anytime we wish. Past volunteers get auto invite. Parents should be part of program.
- Figure out a way to introduce program into CGAA w/Gambling putting some \$\$ toward & split between divisions. 3- year is good. Any way to have a "mass overview" w/out buying too many books. YES, possible. Don't cap it, but 125 is a "magic" number at "mass" setting, but nothing specific on max number attendance. Dan H. meet with Dan Smoot & Phil to collaborate and vote on financing discuss w/each division and gambling. Similar to Park HS coaching program.
