- October 1st when late fee comes into effect. Late fee is \$35. Late fee is only for those USA hockey registered.

Registration for the 2014-2015 hockey season is now open! Visit our website for details. Fees, deposits and fundraiser requirements have remained the same.

****NEW THIS YEAR***

- 1: We have waived all online/credit card processing fees Please pay online with check or credit card if you are able. You will have four payment options:
- a. payment in full online
- b. set up automatic installments online (1/3 now, 1/3 Oct 1st and 1/3 Nov 1st)
- c. mail in check- pay in full or provide 3 checks (1/3 due now and 2 post dated Oct 1 and Nov 1)
- d. give us a check at one of our in-person registrations on Sept 15 or Oct 6, 5-7:00
- 3. Your child will not be allowed on the ice for practice or try outs until all paperwork and registration fees are paid, arranged or you have completed a scholarship application.
- **Step 1: Online Registration:** Complete registration at dchy.org. Mite registration is now done in the same place as the older players.
- Step 2: Hand in forms, payments, and deposits: To ease the stress of the first few weeks of hockey, this year DCYH will be requiring parents have all forms, deposits and payments made before try outs/first practice. Parents will have the opportunity to come and complete this in person on September 15th or October 6th from 5:00-7:00pm or drop the required materials in the DCYH drop box at the rink or mail to DCYH, Attn: Registrar, PO Box 321, Kasson, MN 55944.

Parents will need to submit:

- Consent to treat form per player (form on the website)
- If not paying online, either cash/check for the entire cost of registration, or 3 checks (2 post dated). 1/3 is due with registration, 1/3 due October 1st and 1/3 due November

- One post dated (dated March 1st) check for the concession stand deposit (Memo field should contain: Concession Deposit)
- Copy of the players official birth certificate if you have not done this previously
- Equipment rental form and payment (if applicable)
- Scholarship form (if applicable)
- \$25 try out fee (if applicable, details below)

Step 3a: Try out Number: This year DCYH will require all of the forms, payments and deposits listed in Step 2 to receive the try out number. Players without a try out number will NOT be allowed on the ice to try out. Try out umbers will be provided at the September 15th or October 6th in-person registration at the Kasson Ice Arena from 5:00-7:00pm or the night of the first try out if you previously mailed in all of your forms, payments and deposits listed in Step 2.

Step 3b: Move up request (Squirt and above): There will not be a move up request form for the 2014-2015 season. If your player wants to move up from their age-appropriate level (i.e. Squirt age player wanting to move to Pewee) they will need to pay a \$25 try out fee with registration, partake in try outs and make one of the top 8 player spots of the A team (or highest level) or top 2 goalie spots. If the player does not make one of the top 8 player spots or top 2 goalie spots, they will not be allowed to play up a level for the season and will go back to the age appropriate level of play. If you are planning on doing this, register for your age-appropriate level of play.

Step 3c: Move up request (Supermites): Register for Supermites first. DCYH will have a Supermite evaluation in early October (date TBD). Supermites will need to pay the \$25 try out fee with registration. If the player passes the evaluation, they are guaranteed a spot on a Squirt C team. If the player would like to try and make the Squirt B or Squirt A team, they can attend the Squirt try out sessions and NOT pay the \$25 try-out fee again.

Hockey Operations

- Evaluation all levels- one hours ice time based on skill level.
- U10/U12 first practice together
- Unbiased evaluators
- Move up Policy proposal- move up until age break: June 30th plus two months (August 31st) based on skill. Move up fee \$25 for tryout at upper level. No move up form any longer.

• Move-up Policy

- DCYH has set the following standard ranges for team number
 - o Minimum of 11 players (4 wings, 2 centers, 4 defense, 1 goalie)
 - o Maximum of 15 players (6 wings, 3 centers, 4 defense, 2 goalies)
 - o Ideal number is 13 players
- Board approval will be required to have more than the maximum number of players per team
- Board approval will be required to have less than the minimum number of players per team
- If all teams meet the maximum number of players per the DCYH standards with MN Hockey age appropriate players, move up request will be denied with the following exception
 - Move ups may be granted to players to keep them with their classmates. Example, if a sixth grader is still age eligible for squirts, but most of his class is playing Peewee's, the move up may be granted if they have two years of skating experience)
- All players must have a minimum of 2 years playing experience
- If DCYH needs more players to meet the minimum number of players per team, they may suggest some top talent players from the level below try out. If DCYH request a player to try out because of there are not enough players to make the teams, players can be assigned to a non-A team
- Director of Hockey Operations and ACE Coordinator deem the player to be an instant impact at the A level
 - o Previous years head coach should be contacted
 - o Player must try out and make the A team
 - o Director of Hockey Operations has final decision on moving player up
 - o Impact player being defined as:
 - 1st or 2nd line as forward
 - o Ranked as Top 6 skaters/forwards

- 1st or 2nd Defensive parings
 - o Ranked as Top 4 defenseman
- Starting goalie
- Move in policy proposal

Move-in Guidelines: (Squirt to Bantam).

- Must not force a local DCYH player to be cut
- Must not force an additional team for a specific level (do not bring in 10 ringers and force another Peewee team for example)
- Must make the A team-top 6 skaters, top goalie
- Only good for one year, then the process starts again
- Evaluators will not know the move in candidates during try-outs. The evaluators will rank the players 1-x. If the move-in candidate is not in the top 6, the board will release them back.
- Evaluators will make final A list. Board president plus one board member (not having a child on the current team) will rearrange list if move in is on the list, if necessary.
