#### U17 vs. MUSKEGON LUMBERJACKS

**GAME INFO:** The U.S. National Under-17 Team plays its first USHL opponent of the season when the Muskegon Lumberjacks travel to Ann Arbor Friday night. The game is scheduled for 7 p.m. ET at the Ann Arbor Ice Cube and will be broadcast live on FASTHockey.com **ALL-TIME RECORD:** Muskegon leads series, 17-10-4.



**LAST MEETING:** The Under-18 Team met Muskegon last Friday (Sept. 5) in East Meadow, N.Y., as part of the USHL Atlantic Challenge. Team USA skated to a 5-1 victory over the Lumberjacks, thanks largely to a pair of goals by F **Brendan Warren** and 23 saves from G **Luke Opilka**.

TEAM USA PLAYERS TO WATCH: Six fulltime members of the U.S. National Under-17 Team recorded a point in their first game as members of the NTDP - a 6-3 setback against the Michigan Warriors last Saturday (Sept. 6) in Flint, Mich. F Clayton Keller notched a goal, while F Graham McPhee, F Trent Frederic, F Keeghan Howdeshell, D Michael Campoli and D Adam Fox all had assists. G Joseph Woll started and made 11 saves. G Jake Oettinger entered the contest midway through the second period and turned aside 12 shots.

QUICK FACTS: Friday's contest marks the first of five games between the U.S. National Under-17 Team and Muskegon this season. The NTDP and Muskegon will do battle on 10 occasions in 2014-15, as the U.S. National Under-18 is also scheduled to play the Lumberjacks five times, including the game last weekend in New York ... No other USHL club will play the NTDP as much as Muskegon this winter ... The two teams met in the first round of the 2011 Clark Cup Playoffs, with Team USA falling to the Lumberjacks, 2-0, in the best-of-three series ... F Collin Adams will play against Team USA this weekend after suiting up for the Red, White and Blue in Flint last Saturday. Adams recorded two goals in the U17 Team's 6-3 loss to the Michigan Warriors.

TEAM USA PLAYERS TO WATCH: Thirteen members of the U.S. National Under-18 found the score sheet last weekend at the USHL Atlantic Challenge in East Meadow, N.Y. F Jeremy Bracco (2-1), F Mike Floodstrand (0-3) and D Steven Ruggiero (0-3) all notched three-point weekends. F Brendan Warren and F Luke Kunin collected two goals each. F Matthew Tkachuk, F Colin White and F Jack Roslovic each tallied a goal and an assist. G Luke Opilka made 23 saves in Friday's 5-1 win over Muskegon, while G Michael Lackey stopped 24 shots in Saturday's 4-1 victory against Lincoln. MANTHA AND THE NTDP: Michigan head coach Moe Mantha worked as a head coach at the NTDP from 2000-03, leading the U.S. National Under-17 Team for two seasons (2000-02) and the U.S. National Under-18 Team for one (2002-03). Mantha helped guide the Under-17 Team to a pair of World Under-17 Hockey Challenge championships (2001, 2002), and was behind the bench of the 2003 U.S. Men's National Under-18 Team at the IIHF Men's Under-18 World Championship, leading that squad to a fourth-place finish.

QUICK FACTS: Live stats will be available on USANTDP.com ... Members of the U.S. National Under-18 Team played three games against NAHL foes last winter as members of the Under-17 Team. The U.S. posted three wins and outscored the NAHL teams, 20-5, in those contests ... The Under-18 Team will play an exhibition against the NAHL All-Stars Feb. 23 in Ann Arbor.
