

GAME INFO: The U.S. National Under-18 Team plays its first of two games at the USHL Fall Classic East Tuesday against Cedar Rapids. G Luke Opilka recorded his first shutout as a member of the NTDP last Saturday against the NAHL's Michigan Warriors and, in two starts, has a 0.50 GAA and .974 SV%. G Michael Lackey is 1-0-0 with a 1.00 GAA and .960 SV%. F Troy Terry and F Tage Thompson both notched their first goals as members of the NTDP last weekend. TEAM USA PLAYERS TO WATCH: Team USA F Jeremy Bracco enjoyed considerable success against Youngstown last season, scoring three goals and adding four assists for seven points in four games played. F Jordan Greenway (1-3) and F Christian Fischer (1-3) each had four points against the Phantoms in 2013-14, while F Luke Kunin had three goals and D Caleb Jones had three assists.

Six full-time members of the U.S. National Under-17 Team notched a point two weeks ago against the NAHL's Michigan Warriors. F Clayton Keller scored a goal, while F Graham McPhee, F Trent Frederic, F Keeghan Howdeshell, D Michael Campoli and D Adam Fox all had assists.

QUICK FACTS: Live stats will be available on USANTDP.com. There is no live broadcast of the game ... The contest will serve as a fundraiser for Orchard Lake United, a USA Hockey Model Association ... The NTDP last played a game in Orchard Lake on Sept. 15, 2012 - a 7-1 victory over the Youngstown Phantoms ... Team USA has played LaSalle on two previous occasions. The 2012-13 U.S. National Under-17 Team split the series with the Vipers, winning the first game, 5-1, and falling in the second outing, 9-7. Jack Eichel had two goals and three assists in the two-game set to lead the U.S. in scoring.

FIFTEEN HEADED TO ALL-AMERICAN PROSPECTS GAME

The NTDP will have 15 current players participating in the CCM/USA Hockey All-American Prospects Game Sept. 25 at First Niagara Center in Buffalo, N.Y. The list includes goaltenders Michael Lackey and Luke Opilka; defensemen Nicholas Boka, Christian Evers, Casey Fitzgerald, Grant Gabriele, Caleb Jones and Steven Ruggiero; and forwards Jeremy Bracco, Christian Fischer, Jordan Greenway, Jack Roslovic, Troy Terry, Brendan Warren and Colin White. In addition to the current NTDP players, four NTDP products also received the invite to the AAPG: D Noah Hanifin (Boston College), D Zach Werenski (University of Michigan), F Jack Eichel (Boston University) and F Dennis Yan. F Kyle Connor, who helped the U.S. Men's National Under-18 Team win the gold medal at the 2014 IIHF Men's Under-18 World Championship, is also slated to participate in the AAPG. U.S. National Under-18 F Mike Floodstand was invited to play in the game, but will be unable to participate.

SEVEN ON NHL CENTRAL SCOUTING'S FUTURES LIST

Seven members of the 2014-15 U.S. National Under-18 Team were included on NHL Central Scouting's Futures list, released this summer. The players include forwards Jeremy Bracco, Christian Fischer, Jordan Greenway and Colin White; and defensemen Nicholas Boka and Casey Fitzgerald. Under-18 Team F Auston Matthews and Under-18 head coach Don Granato both attended the USA Hockey National Junior Evaluation Camp in Lake Placid, N.Y., this summer. Matthews, who is eligible for the 2016 NHL Entry Draft, collected six points (2-4) in six games, including multi-point efforts against Sweden (two goals) and Finland (two assists). Granato will serve as an assistant coach for the 2015 U.S. National Junior Team.
