2014-15 SERIES: Both NTDP clubs have faced Muskegon already this season. The U18 Team knocked off the Lumberjacks, 5-1, on Sept. 5 at the USHL Atlantic Challenge in East Meadow, N.Y., and the U17s fell to Muskegon, 1-0, in Ann Arbor on Sept. 12.

TEAM USA PLAYERS TO WATCH: G **Joseph Woll** made 32 saves in the U.S. National Under-17 Team's 1-0 loss to Muskegon two weeks ago, boosting his SV% to .956 and knocking his GAA down to 1.36. Six members of the U17 Team have notched points through two games played this year, including F **Clayton Keller**, who has one goal. Five others - F **Graham McPhee**, F **Trent Frederic**, F **Keeghan Howdeshell**, D **Michael Campoli** and D **Adam Fox** - have one assist each.

QUICK FACTS: The game is the second of five scheduled match ups between the U17 Team and Muskegon this season. The NTDP will meet the Lumberjacks a total of 10 times in 2014-15, as the U.S. National Under-18 Team also plays Muskegon on five occasions (including Sunday in Ann Arbor) ... No other USHL team will play the NTDP as much as Muskegon this year ... The two teams met in the first round of the 2011 Clark Cup Playoffs, with Team USA falling to the Lumberjacks, 2-0, in the best-of-three series ... Muskegon F Collin Adams will play against Team USA this weekend after suiting up for the Under-17 Team against the NAHL's Michigan Warriors on Sept. 6.

TEAM USA PLAYERS TO WATCH: F Colin White (1-2) and F Jeremy Bracco (0-3) each had three-point efforts in the game last week, while F Matthew Tkachuk scored twice and G Luke Opilka turned in a 20-save performance. Bracco enjoyed considerable success against Youngstown last season, scoring three goals and adding four assists for seven points in four games played. F Jordan Greenway (1-3) and F Christian Fischer (1-3) each had four points against the Phantoms in 2013-14, while F Luke Kunin had three goals and D Caleb Jones had three assists.

QUICK FACTS: This contest marks the second of six between the Under-18 Team and Youngstown in 2014-15. The two clubs will next meet on Oct. 10 in Ann Arbor ... The Under-17 Team is scheduled to play Youngstown three times this year, with the first contest slated for Oct. 3. Phantoms F Kyle Connor skated with the 2013-14 U.S. National Under-18 Team during the IIHF Men's Under-18 World Championship in Finland. His five goals and three assists helped Team USA capture the gold medal.

The NTDP had 15 current players in the CCM/USA Hockey All-American Prospects Game Sept. 25 Buffalo, N.Y. The list included goaltenders Michael Lackey and Luke Opilka; defensemen Nicholas Boka, Christian Evers, Casey Fitzgerald, Grant Gabriele, Caleb Jones and Steven Ruggiero; and forwards Jeremy Bracco, Christian Fischer, Jordan Greenway, Jack Roslovic, Troy Terry, Brendan Warren and Colin White. In addition to the current NTDP players, four products also skated in the AAPG: D Noah Hanifin (Boston College), D Zach Werenski (University of Michigan), F Jack Eichel (Boston University) and F Dennis Yan. Bracco (2-0), Eichel (1-1), and Greenway (0-2) all registered two points while playing on a line together for a majority of the contest, and Lackey (15 saves/16 shots) and Opilka (22 saves/23 shots) started for their respective teams and played 29:48 each. Warren (1-0), Gabriele (0-1), and White (0-1) all had one point. Under-18 Team F Mike Floodstand was invited to play in the game, but was unable to participate. Eichel (2011-13) was named Player of the Game. U18 Team coaches Don Granato and Nick Fohr served as assistant coaches at the event.
