#### 2. Annual Election

# 3. Treasure Report

Patty Preblich reports that we are \$166 within proposed budget for 2014 (under). Currently we have \$19,000 in the bank. Much of this will be used for repairs and updates.

# 4. Move the start of baseball games to 6pm for the 2015 season

Rationale: This will allow the league to get games in before dark as well as get our workers home sooner. The other leagues also start at 6:00 PM.

Members felt the advantages out weighed the disadvantages of starting the games at 6:00 PM. Vote: motion passed

## 5. Update on the equipment return (Chris Summerfield)

Unfortunately there are still a lot of equipment bags still checked out. The last turn-in date is **Monday**, **October 13 from 6-9 PM**. Chris had offered several dates to our coaches. He reports the equipment is coming in cleaner this year. The board appreciates Chris' work on the equipment.

## 6. Fall Baseball Review and Feedback (John Golden)

There were 6 teams this year (we are adding 1 team a year). This year there was only 1 day of evaluations. Next year there will be 2 or 3 evaluation dates. John will need help with evaluations next year. The program seems to be going well. Coach evaluations will be sent out to fall baseball parents as well as regular season parents. There doesn't seem to be talk among the players/coaches to encourage fall ball. It was suggested to include that in coaches meetings at the beginning of the season. Fall baseball teams had new uniforms this year. Shoreview liked the uniforms because it had S instead of C - John Golden received a lot of positive comments about the program. # 7. Discussion about Open House for the 2015 season

#### 9. New Business

#### <u>Lexington Park Upgrade:</u>

Becky and Pat went to a meeting with the city of Lexington. The city is looking at upgrading Lexington Park. The city gave the CLLL a few options. Fields 1,2 and 3 will remain. Fields 4 and 5 will be located by the current park entrance. There will be a natural park in the area currently occupied by fields 4 and 5. There will be a new concession area. The current concession stand will be bathrooms. The batting cage currently between 2 and 3 will be moved as well. There will be approximately 150 paved parking places. CLLL gave them ideas for the design of concession stand.

There will be irrigation on the fields and new sod. The final approval from the city board will be in January. The City of Lexington is writing a grant for most of this work. At this time we do not know what monetary responsibilities will be expected of CLLL. The work will be done in phases.

#### Lions and Carl Eck

Work continues by Lions and Carl Eck. When the road work is finished we will have new parking and sidewalks.

#### Batter's Box - Carl Eck/Lions

Dan Whelan is making a template for chalking the batters box at Carl Eck. This will give the players an accurate and consistent batters box.

#### Constitution

Chris Reff brought copies of the constitution used by CLLL.

Motion was made to publish the current CLLL constitution on our league web site.

Motion: Chris Reff Second: John Golden Discussion: Members noted the constitution does not currently reflect our current practices. It was noted that we need to publish the document as it exists now even though the board will be proposing changes over the next several months. Vote: motion passed

#### National League Baseball Rep

Pat Mahr announced he will no longer be the National League Representative. He is stepping down from that position. Pat nominated Steve Klebba for this appointed position.

#### <u>Proposed Changes to the CLLL Constitution</u>

Motion was made to change the name in our constitution to Centennial Lakes Little League. **Motion**: Chris Reff **Second**: Mike Marso **Discussion**: none **Vote**: motion passed NOTE: since this change was voted on during the October 12th meeting. The published constitution on our web site WILL reflect this change.

Motion was made to add an adoption page for board members to sign. The constitution should be reviewed each year and each board member should sign it. This motion will add a page for signatures.

There is still an opening for T-Ball representative. If there are any members interested in this position they should contact Chris Reff.

<u>Ken Manning</u> addressed the board regarding adding a position of a field coordinator. Ken is concerned about the conditions of some of our fields. One example of poor conditions would be a lip on the 3rd base at Sunrise or weeds on fields. He is suggesting that our league advertise for a person to be a field coordinator. It was suggested that we could leave rakes at the fields in lock boxes. Ken offered a lot of suggestions on the correct ways to groom the fields. The people hired to groom the fields will get more instruction to improve the conditions of Carl Eck and Lions fields.
