## SCORING GAMES USING NGIN LIVE SCORING SYSTEM

1. Go to team home page
2. Click on 'Game Schedule'
3. Click on game desired in 'game ribbon' (vertical schedule with game dates)
4. Click on 'Score Live'
5. On 'Game Detail' tab, check for accuracy of date and time
a. Add Location \& Weather data (optional)
b. Click on 'Save Game Details'
c. Click 'OK'
6. Click on 'Teams/Rosters' tab (right side)
7. For BOTH teams, check all active players
a. DO NOT check back-up goalies at this point
b. Select starting goalies from dropdown boxes for both teams
c. Click on 'Score Game'
8. If scoring 'live' during game, enter 'events' as they happen
a. GOAL
i. Click on GOAL
ii. Click on scoring team
iii. Select scorer and any assists
iv. Make sure the correct goalie is shown
v. Enter time (use actual time shown on rink scoreboard)
vi. Mark goal location by clicking on rink where shot came from (optional)
vii. Select 'play action' (even strength, power play, etc.)
viii. Add + or - (optional—can be done afterward as an edit)
ix. Click 'Next Play’
b. PENALTY
i. Click on 'Penalty'
ii. Click on team that incurred the penalty
iii. Select skater that was charged with the penalty (unless bench minor)
9. If bench minor, leave skater field as 'Bench'
10. Select player from 'served by' from dropdown box
iv. Select 'infraction type' from dropdown box
v. Enter time (use actual time shown on rink scoreboard)
vi. Click on penalty location (optional)
vii. Select 'play action' (minor, major, etc.)
viii. Choose 'Results in Power play' or 'No Power Play'
ix. Click on 'Next Play'
c. SHOT (a more accurate term would be Saves, as that is what you enter here)
i. At end of period, click on 'Shot'
ii. Select team, ensure opposing goalie is shown
iii. For shot count, use number of SAVES the goalie made in that period
iv. Set time for 0:00 (end of period)
v. Click on 'Next Play'
vi. Repeat for other team
d. Goalie Changes/Empty Net Situations
i. Goalie Change
11. Click on 'MENU' (top left corner of page in small letters)
12. Click on 'Game Settings'
13. Click on 'Teams/Rosters' tab
14. Check back-up goalie that will be coming in
15. Click on 'Score Game' to go back to scoring page
16. Click on 'Goalie Change'
17. Click on team that is changing goalies
18. From dropdown box, select new goalie
19. Enter time (use actual time shown on rink scoreboard)
20. Click on 'Next Play'
21. Credit first goalie with saves by doing the following:
a. Click on 'Shot'
b. Click on opposing team
c. Use dropdown box to select first goalie
d. For shot count, use number of SAVES the goalie made in that period
e. For time, enter the time on the scoreboard that the goalie was removed
f. Click on 'Next Play'
22. For second goalie, use procedure shown in 8c (above)
ii. Empty Net
23. Click on 'Goalie Change'
24. Select team that is pulling the goalie
25. Click on the ' $x$ ' to the right of the goalie's name
26. Enter time (use actual time shown on rink scoreboard)
27. Click on 'Next Play'
28. If a goal is scored, make sure the team scored upon's goalie shows 'EMPTY NET' (you can use dropdown box to change if needed)
29. Enter pulled goalie's saves by using procedure 8 d (11) above
30. If goalie comes back out, switch goalie from 'Empty Net' to goalie name. Enter time as shown above.
iii. After shots/saves are recorded, click on 'Start New Period', then 'Next Play'

## 9. END OF GAME

a. Make sure all goals/penalties/saves (shots) are recorded
b. In upper left, click on 'Finalize Game' (small letters)
c. In Referee Sign-off, type in your name, then click on 'Finalize Game'
(This method can be used after games as well, entering goals/assists/penalties/shots/saves from scoresheet for BOTH teams.)
