2014-15 SERIES: The U.S. National Under-18 Team scored 10 goals in a 10-5 win over the RoughRiders at the USHL Fall Classic East in Green Bay, Wis., on Sept. 16.

TEAM USA PLAYERS TO WATCH: F Clayton Keller leads the U17s with six points (2-4) in six USHL outings ... Keller is tied for the team lead in goals during league play with F **Joey Anderson**, F **William Lockwood** and F **Nick Pastujov** ... D **Chad Krys** has a team-best three helpers during USHL competition ... G **Jake Oettinger** and G **Joseph Woll** have a .947 and .915 save percentage in their last four games, respectively.

QUICK FACTS: The U17s and Cedar Rapids will play four times this winter, as the younger NTDP group travels to lowa for a two-game weekend against the RoughRiders in January ... The U18s don't play Cedar Rapids again in 2014-15.

F **Auston Matthews** paces all U.S. skaters with four goals against college foes in 2014-15 ... F **Matthew Tkachuk** has seven points (2-5) in six games against NCAA squads ... Two of D **Casey Fitzgerald**'s three goals this winter have come against college teams.

QUICK FACTS: The NTDP has produced 26 players who have gone on to play for the University of Minnesota. Just two programs - Michigan (36) and Notre Dame (32) - have had more National Team Development Program alumni ... Five current Gophers played their pre-collegiate puck in Ann Arbor, including Travis Boyd (2009-11), Ryan Collins (2012-14), Hudson Fasching (2011-13), Jack Glover (2012-14) and Brady Skjei (2010-12) ... Just one current member of the National Team Development Program is committed to Minnesota - D Ryan Lindgren of the Under-17 squad.

QUICK FACTS: This is the second of five games the U.S. National Under-18 Team will play against NCAA Division III opponents. The U18s will play two DIII squads next weekend in Ann Arbor, with Neumann University visiting the Ann Arbor Ice Cube Saturday (Nov. 29) before the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point takes the ice against the elder NTDP team Sunday (Nov. 30). USA TO HOST 2014 U17 FOUR NATIONS TOURNAMENT

USA Hockey and the National Team Development Program will host the 2014 Four Nations Tournament Dec. 16-20 at the Ann Arbor Ice Cube. The Under-17 Team will play games against Russia, Switzerland and Slovakia in preliminary-round action before the tournament championship and third-place games on Saturday, Dec. 20. U17S EARN SECOND PLACE AT WORLD U17 CHALLENGE

The U.S. National Under-17 Team took home second-place honors at the World Under-17 Challenge from Nov. 2-8 in Sarnia and Lambton Shores, Ont. Team USA compiled a 5-0-0-0 record before falling to Russia, 2-1, in the championship game. The second-place finish marked the ninth consecutive finish in the top-three at the event by the United States. Team USA has won four titles in the tournament, including 2001, 2002, 2010 and 2014 (Jan.). F **Max Jones**, F **Clayton Keller** and D **Chad Krys** were named to the All-Tournament Team.

U18S WIN FOUR NATIONS TOURNAMENT IN SWEDEN

The U.S. National Under-18 Team was in Sweden last week competing with Finland, Switzerland and Sweden for the U18 Four Nations Tournament title. Team USA stormed past Finland (8-1) and Switzerland (7-1) before knocking off the Swedes, 6-4, in the championship game. The three wins and a 4-3 triumph over Sweden in a pre-tournament contest ups the 1997 NTDP group's overall international record to 19-0-0. The group won all three of its international events last season.

BRACCO CLOSING IN ON NTDP ALL-TIME ASSIST RECORD

U18 Team F **Jeremy Bracco** is one assist away from tying the all-time NTDP career assist record, which is 88 and currently shared by J.D. Forrest (1997-2000) - an assistant coach with the Under-18 Team - and Patrick Kane (2004-06). Last season, Bracco notched the single-season assist record with 58.

TWENTY-ONE ON NHL CENTRAL SCOUTING'S WATCH LIST

Twenty-one players with ties to the NTDP were included on NHL Center Scouting's Preliminary 2015 Players to Watch list, released earlier this week. The current NTDPers on the list are goaltenders Michael Lackey and Luke Opilka; defensemen Nicholas Boka, Christian Evers, Casey Fitzgerald, Grant Gabriele, Caleb Jones and Steven Ruggiero; and forwards Jeremy Bracco, Christian Fischer, Jordan Greenway, Jack Roslovic, Troy Terry, Brendan Warren and Colin White. Six alumni of the National Team Development Program - G Ed Minney (Michigan State University); D Noah Hanifin (Boston College), D Zach Werenski (University of Michigan), F Jack Eichel (Boston University), F Ryan Hitchcock (Yale University) and F Dennis Yan - were also included on the list. Greenway, White, Eichel, Hanifin, and Werenski were each "A" rated prospects, meaning they are projected to be first-round picks in the 2015 NHL Entry Draft.
