GAME INFO: The U.S. National Under-18 Team continues its road swing with a one-game stop in East Lansing to play Michigan State University Friday night at 7 p.m. The game will be broadcast live on Fox Sports Detroit Plus



ALL-TIME RECORD: Team USA leads, 6-4-0.

LAST MEETING: The U.S. National Under-18 Team collected its second-straight win over MSU with a 4-3 overtime victory last season (March 1, 2014).

TEAM USA PLAYERS TO WATCH: F **Auston Matthews** played with the U18s last season in East Lansing and collected one goal and two shots on net ... Matthews, who is making his first appearance since returning from the IIHF World Junior Championship, leads Team USA with 24 goals and 49 points in 27 games ... F **Matthew Tkachuk** ranks second on the team in goals (20) and third in points (42) ... F **Jeremy Bracco** boasts a team-best 35 assists and is second overall with 47 points.

QUICK FACTS: The National Team Development Program has produced 21 players who have gone on to play at Michigan State all-time, including current MSU players G Ed Minney (2012-14/Wind Gap, Pa.) and F Dylan Pavelek (2012-14/Marysville, Mich.) ... NTDP U17 Team head coach Danton Cole played for the Spartans from 1985-89, helping the club to the NCAA national title in 1986. Cole also was a two-year assistant captain, received the Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1989 and in 2012-13 was awarded the Distinguished Spartan Award.

U18 Team F **Auston Matthews** made the 2015 U.S. National Junior Team roster for the IIHF World Junior Championship in Montreal and Toronto. In five games played, Matthews collected three points (1-2), including a game-winner, and tied for third on the team with 16 shots on goal.

UNDER-17 TEAM EARNS SECOND PLACE AT U17 FOUR NATIONS

The U.S. National Under-17 Team took home second-place honors at the 2014 U17 Four Nations Tournament, which took place Dec. 16-20 in Ann Arbor. The U.S. fell to Russia, 3-2, in the tournament title game. F Clayton Keller (3-5=8), F Joey Anderson (2-4=6) and F Nick Pastujov (5-0=5) were the top scorers in the event.

FLOODSTRAND, MASONIUS PICKED FOR USHL TOP PROSPECTS GAME

U18 Team F **Michael Floodstrand** and D **Joe Masonius** were both tabbed to participate in the upcoming USHL/NHL Top Prospects Game Jan. 13 at Mystique Community Ice Center in Dubuque, Iowa. Floodstrand, who was picked to play in the August USA Hockey All-American Prospects Game but couldn't participate due to illness, has three goals and eight points in 23 outings. Masonius boasts a team-leading 15 points (5-10) among U18 Team defensemen and has played in all 31 games this winter.

BRACCO BREAKS NTDP CAREER ASSISTS RECORD

U18 Team F Jeremy Bracco broke the all-time NTDP career assist record last weekend against Augsburg College. Bracco now has 89 assists in his time at the NTDP, passing J.D. Forrest (1997-2000) - an assistant coach with the Under-18 Team - and Patrick Kane (2004-06), who both had 88. Last season, Bracco notched the single-season assist record with 58.

CAMPOLI, HOWDESHELL MAKE VERBAL COLLEGE COMMITMENTS

Two U.S. National Under-17 Team members recently made verbal commitments to play NCAA Division I hockey. D **Michael Campoli** picked Boston College as his post-NTDP destination, while Michigan native F **Keeghan Howdeshell** will stay instate and play for Ferris State University.

Under-17 Team D **Adam Fox** was selected as the USHL's co-Defensive Player of the Week on Jan. 5 after notching four points (1-3) in a two-game sweep of Green Bay.
