| | Increase the volunteer fee. How much? Travelling Softball charges \$150, the participation rate of volunteers is much higher due to the amount of the deposit. | |
| | Concerns that parents will complain if we raise the volunteer deposit. We need to be diligent in reminding coaches/parents that we don't want their money we want their time. | |
| | If we charge too much and everyone decides to volunteer, the fear is there wouldn't be enough positions to fill for entire season. If all shifts for concession stands and tournaments were filled it would come out to approximately 450 families. Over 700 kids were in Rec baseball in 2014, we need to estimate volunteer opportunities for 600 sets of parents in 2015 if they were all to volunteer. | |

| | If we collect a (uncashed) check from parents and need to pay out to umpires/concessions/etc during the season is there a potential to run into cash flow issues? | |
| | Since there are some parents who know immediately they don't wish to volunteer, could we use the registration form to have those who don't want to volunteer to let us know at registration? This way we can figure out how many positions we would need during the season along with mitigating some of the cash flow issues (i.e. we would immediately use their volunteer fee) (Answer from Nancy – we could do this on the registration form if we wanted to.) | |
| | Can we find out how many parents gave up their fee in 2014 / how many hours were paid for workers? (Answer from Nancy – 379 volunteered but that includes 8U fast pitch parents as well as coaches) | |
| | For base ball since the fee is collected online and done via credit card, Nancy puts a credit to the account once the volunteer time is completed. (Answer from Nancy - we pay 2.5% to credit the account once someone has volunteered. The process is simpler to do it this way + skip fees for stamps.) | |

Volunteering - How to schedule the volunteer time

Current system is for Nancy to send outemails asking for volunteers, softball uses the "dibs" portion of the league website to avoid all the extra emails.

If the board is diligent enough we could have all volunteer positions available during registration and have parents able to sign up before the season even starts.
