Winner's Circle

Just as it's important to start every game with a conversation, it's equally important to have a postgame conversation.

"Winner's Circle" is a more high-energy way to bring closure to a game. Players stand in a circle, often linking arms. The floor is open to anyone who wants to offer appreciation and recognition to another team member. After each person speaks, the entire circle moves to give that player a high-five. At the end you can recognize players who contributed who haven't been recognized.

Even in a losing effort, your players did many positive things that deserve recognition!
