Joe Baldarotta coached six seasons at Cortland from 2007-13 and led the Red Dragons to the 2008 SUNYAC Playoffs. His overall coaching record of 310-266-49 includes a 265-171-38 mark at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point in 16 years from 1991-2007. Baldarotta led the Pointers to the 1993 national championship as well as NCAA runner-up finishes in 1992 and 1998. Under his guidance the Pointers also claimed three regular season NCHA titles and two postseason titles. The four-time NCHA coach of the year also was named the 1993 ACHA national coach of the year.
