OSA SOCCER PLAYER REGISTRATION

OSA will be having registration for U10–U18 boys and girls traveling teams for the MYSA summer league. Children with birth dates between 8/1/96 and 7/31/05 are eligible. Registration will be held Monday, January 26 and Tuesday, January 27 from 6:00–8:00 p.m. at OHS in Rooms A210-211 (enter door near tennis court). The cost will be \$175 per player. (A \$10 late fee will be assessed for players registering after January 27.) A fundraiser payment also must be made at the time of registration.

A child is officially registered when he/she:

- 1. Has parent complete and sign **Registration Form** and **Medical Release Form** (download from website or copies will be available to fill out at registration).
- 2. Submits a recent small **photo** that can be cut down to 1" x 1."
- 3. New players submit a photocopy of a <u>birth</u> certificate.
- 4. <u>Pays the registration fee</u> of \$175. Checks are payable to OSA (plus uniform fee if needed).
- 5. Pays for the fundraiser (\$100 per player, \$150 for families with more than one player. Checks payable to OSA.) These fundraiser checks will not be cashed for 60 days. Each player will be asked to sell or use 10 HyVee coupon books. 5 additional books for families with 2 or more players. The books sell for \$10 each.
- 6. Pays concession stand fee of \$50. If a family member works a shift at our concession stand during the summer or fall or participates in another approved OSA volunteer activity, they will be reimbursed the \$50 fee. Concession stand signups will be available at www.owatonnasoccer.org. You are responsible for signing up so please watch for notices.

Teams fill up quickly. Those individuals who sign up after January 27 may not be able to play if there are no openings. If enough players don't register to form a team at a particular age level, full refunds will be made unless the player moves up to play on an older team. If you have any questions about registration, please contact a board member.

NEW UNIFORMS

All new players will need to buy a new uniform for \$70 which includes 2 shirts, 1 pair of shorts (\$10) and 2 pairs of socks (\$10/2).

SUMMER SOCCER CAMP

The OSA Board is proud to announce that our club will be directly affiliated with the Wolverhampton Wanderers in 2015. Wolverhampton is a professional **English** Championship League team that has been in the English Premier League in recent years. OSA is excited about this opportunity as it will not only give our youth direct access to a professional English club, but it will also provide additional coaches material and training that has been developed by a youth academy in England.

An additional perk to our new affiliation with Wolverhampton is that we will be hosting an International ID camp. The ID camp will be run by a trainer from the Wolverhampton youth academy. If a player is recognized at our camp, he/she could be invited to a national ID camp, and if noticed there, an international ID camp in England! The date is yet to be determined but the target dates are the first or second weekend in June. Keep watch on the OSA website for additional information.

COACHES AND TEAM MANAGERS NEEDED

OSA is an all-volunteer organization. We again will need coaches and team managers for the upcoming season. Please indicate on your child's registration form if you are willing to help us out in one of these capacities or in other ways. Coaches will be assigned by and contacted by Todd Trout.

MYSA has a symposium at the Minneapolis Convention Center on Saturday, February 7 for coaches that costs \$70 if you register by January 23 (OSA will reimburse the \$70 if you pre-register on the MYSA website by the cutoff date). OSA will have training for coaches in February-April; dates and times are yet to be determined. If you are interested in earning your "E" license, a course will be held in St. Louis Park on Feb 27-March 1 and in Maple Grove on April 11-12 (the cost of \$200 will be reimbursed by OSA). PLAYER TRAINING

Training for all players will also be held with dates/times to be announced at registration. U10-U12 will be separated from the U13 and above to give each age group more specific training designed for their needs. Player cost for training will be \$15 for the first child and \$10 for each additional child per family. SCHEDULES/TEAM MEETINGS

Practices start as soon as fields are available. League games run from approximately May 4 to July 8. District/regional playoffs will be held between July 11–16. Teams qualifying for the state tournament will start play July 19. League games are on Monday / Wednesday or Tuesday / Thursday nights. Also, each team will play in at least 2 MYSA sanctioned tournaments that are held on weekends. Team meetings will be held as soon as teams are formed. Coaches will be calling with more information on the dates of team meetings and practices.

9 AND 10 YEAR OLD PLAYERS

The OSA board has decided to have 10-year old teams for 2015 Summer and Fall leagues. For younger children with birthdates after 7/31/05 OSA encourages them to play in the Owatonna Park and Rec soccer program during the spring.

CLOTHING/EQUIPMENT

Players are asked to provide their own shinguards and soccer shoes for practices and games. It is requested that each player bring their own soccer ball for all team practices. The U10 – U12 teams use a size 4 ball and all other ages use a size 5.

SCHOLARSHIPS
