Executive Board—2 positions up for election/3 yr term

The duties of the Board of Directors shall include:

- To manage the business, property, and affairs of the Corporation
- To formulate the policies and determine the overall conduct and standards of the hockey program, which shall be administered by the officers.
- To establish a budget and set fees for the hockey programs.
- To study for approval proposals to amend or revise the Corporation's By-Laws, rules or regulations.
- To review and act upon any temporary decision by the President.
- To hear and rule on appeals.
- Attendance at Monthly Board Meetings and Spring planning

Electronic Voting:

On February 16th, members will receive an exclusive link to our election site, to cast their vote on-line. Online voting will remain open for one week, closing at 8:30pm on Election Day.

Your ability to vote online is linked to the email address provided in your player's registration. Only the emails provided at registration will receive the link and ability to vote online. Each parent is entitled to one vote.

If you only registered with one email, only that email will be able to vote online. In this case, the other parent can still exercise their right to vote by casting their vote in person on election night, 2/23 from 5:30-8:30pm at the rink.
