Thank you for participating in the 2015 New Ulm Basketball Association home tournament. Enclosed are the brackets for your grade level and a map with the locations of the New Ulm High School, Vogel Fieldhouse, Jefferson Elementary and Washington Elementary.

Listed below are the **4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade Boys and Girls** rules for the tournament:

Home team is top team on the bracket or the team to the right in pool play.

**\*\*\*\*\*Home team will be responsible for keeping the official book at the scorers table.**

- ☐ Coaches are responsible to keep their players off the courts between games and half times. One warning will be issued; second time will result in child being disqualified from tournament.
- ☐ 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Boys and 4<sup>th</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> Girls - Games will be 12 minute stop time-halves.
- ☐ 3 minute half-time.
- ☐ If one team is ahead by 20 or more points, the clock continues to run.
- ☐ 6<sup>th</sup> Boys and 6<sup>th</sup> Girls – Teams may press man to man the whole game unless up by more than 20 points.
- ☐ 5<sup>th</sup> Boys and 5<sup>th</sup> Girls - Teams may press the last 2 minutes of each half unless up by 10 points or more.
- ☐ 4<sup>th</sup> Boys and 4<sup>th</sup> girls- NO pressing allowed.
- ☐ No zone defenses will be allowed.
- ☐ 1<sup>st</sup> overtime period shall be 2 minutes. 2<sup>nd</sup> overtime period will be sudden death.
- ☐ Each team will be allowed 3 full time-outs per game and 1 per team in overtime.
- ☐ One & one bonus will be given after the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul, 2-shot bonus after the 10<sup>th</sup> team foul.
- ☐ Technical fouls to players or coaches will result in 2 points and possession of the ball for the opposing team.
- ☐ All other Minnesota State High School League rules will apply.

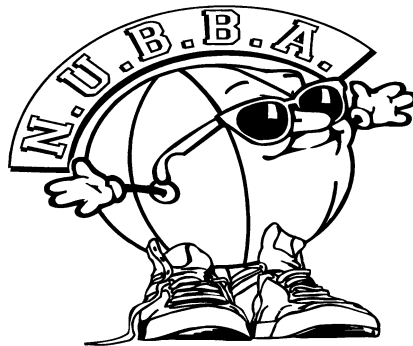

Listed below are the **7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Boys and Girls** rules for the tournament:

Home team is top team on the bracket or the team to the right of pool play.

**\*\*\*\*Home team will be responsible for keeping official book at the scorers table.**

- Coaches are responsible to keep their players off the courts between games and halftimes. One warning will be issued; second time will result in child disqualified from tournament.
- ❑ Games will be 12 minute stop-time halves.
- ❑ 3 minute half-time.
- ❑ If one team is ahead by 20 or more points, the clock continues to run.
- ❑ **Teams may press throughout the game unless up by 20 or more.**
- ❑ **Zone defenses will be allowed.**
- ❑ 1<sup>st</sup> overtime period shall be 2 minutes. 2<sup>nd</sup> overtime period will be sudden death.
- ❑ Each team will be allowed 3 full time-outs per game and 1 per team in overtime.
- ❑ One & one bonus will be given after the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul, 2-shot bonus after the 10<sup>th</sup> team foul.
- ❑ Technical fouls to players or coaches will result in 2 points and possession of the ball for the opposing team.
- ❑ All other Minnesota State High School League rules will apply.

T-shirts will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Awards will be limited to 12 for each team.
