- 1. Follow the bracket board at all time.
- 2. All teams must have at least 3 but no more than 4 players registered. All games will start with 3 players on each team. Any number (1 or 2) may complete the game.
- 3. Players listed on the roster are the only players eligible to compete on the team.
- 4. Each team is allowed two 45 second timeouts. These stop play, but the game clock continues to run. Timeouts in the last 2 minutes stop the clock.
- 5. Unlimited substitution, buy only after a made basket or when the ball is not in play.
- 6. Before games both teams will warm up at the same time. Games start no later than 5 minutes past the scheduled time. The 3 Minutes of warm up may be included in your 20 minute game.

- 7. One captain is expected to represent his/her team in case of disagreement or appeal.
- 8. court referees will be present to keep score, call fouls when necessary, act as a referee and have the final say in disputes.
- 9. NO STALLING! There will be an unwritten 30 second shot clock in effect at all times. Failure to shoot in a 30 second period will result in a loss of possession.
- 10. NO DUNKING! Dunking at any time, including the warmup period is against the rules. This may result in the disqualification of the individual.
- 11. Jump balls go to the defense.
- 12. A coin flip will start the game.
- 13. After fouls or ball out-of-bounds, the ball will be checked at the two point line.
- 14. All games are to 15 points win by 2 or 20 minutes, the 20 minutes may include the warm up period. If tied after 20 minutes, two 1-minute overtime periods will be played. If still tied, sudden death will be played. (Coin flip will determine possession).
- 15. All baskets count as one point except for shots made from behind the two-point line, these baskets will count as two points. Both feet must be completely behind the line for the basket to count two points.
