The motion to approve this request was made by Brian Swenson and seconded by Blake Palmer. Motion approved 7/0. Julie has negotiated with the Tavern to continue with gambling. They will reduce their profit from 20% to 10%. The Tavern will also add pull tabs when they host large events. Julie reports that we have available funds to transfer from gambling to the general fund. A motion was made by Blake Palmer and seconded by Bill McNamara to transfer \$30,000 from gambling to the general fund to be used to subsidize summer hockey programs. Approved 10:0. A motion was also made by Brian Swenson and seconded by Blake Palmer to transfer \$20,000 to cover January ice fees that were not billed to parents of traveling skaters. Approved 10:0.

Treasurer Report:

All ice fees for the 2014-2015 season have been billed. A note was attached to all delinquent accounts stating that all accounts must be current for their skaters to participate in Districts. There is no January ice bill due to the \$100 ice credit that BYHA approved. Our tax return for year ending June 2014 must be signed by tomorrow. Blake will sign this to avoid filing an extension. 1099 will be ready by the end of January. It was recommended that we secure a copy of the audit that was one on the rink and the golf course. Our current balance is \$203,740.08 with \$40,000 in outstanding checks for an adjusted total of \$163,740.00

Secretary Report:

Changes to the minutes from December will be made with the amended version posted once completed.

Tournament Report/Volunteer:

The net profit from our last tournament is not yet available. We will try to include some advertisements in our next two home program tournament programs. We will be hosting the Bantam B Region tournament. It will be coordinated by Steve Pearson. We have had great response for the DIBS on tournaments so far this season. There are two tournaments left to post, but a lot of people still need hours to complete their required amount. We will look at these balances once the DIBS for all tournaments are filled.

Hockey Operations Report:

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The HOC report was given by Bob Driver. HOC has been discussing the development of a timeline for the entire hockey year that would include everything from tryouts, season, spring and summer training.

Girl's Hockey: Delano has been meeting with the youth hockey program and the high school administration. Some parents have expressed the desire to stop the co-op that we currently have with Delano from U14 through high school.

Tryouts: The overall feedback on tryouts is that they went well. They would like to make sure that tryouts are 40% skills and 60% live play. Delano would like more representation at the U14 level. Tryouts will most likely be moved early next year to make it easier to meet registration deadlines.

Squirt/U10: HOC discussed where to place girls at this level: all girls play with boys; wave out girls that want to play U10; or continue with separate boys and girls if the numbers support this. Any girl at this age would still be allowed to try out to play with the squirts.

Coaching Coordinator: Three coaches still need to complete the safe sport video.

Tournaments: BYHA is considering decreasing the number of tournaments we host to three total, one each month, December, January, February. This would free up ice time and ned for two a day practices.

Drylands: Coaches are responsible for sign-up online. The dry land area has been very messy and equipment is disappearing. There has been discussion about a storage shed or some other way to secure the area. The other suggestions were hiring somebody to monitor the area and developing written procedures and expectations..

End of Year Play: It was noted that teams advancing onto regions will be given priority times for ice times.

Mites: the skaters this year were not assigned dots to signify their grouping by ability. We may want to return to this system next year. There is some confusion with in house vs. out of house games, but Bob reminded us that our mite program is not designed to be a traveling program. Jamboree/tournaments will be limited and HOC will continue to work through these issues. There is also discussion about separation of the girls or combining all of the skaters together.

Marketing:

The golf tournament and break the ice social will be held on September 19th. We will still collect baskets from teams this season and store them. Committee members for this event: Sarah Carrothers, Sally O'Borsky, Steph Kohnen, Heidi Sohler.

New Business:

We have received several complaints regarding the quality of the pictures that were taken this year. Fundraiser: A member of our BYHA community is suffering from Stage IV cancer. There is a benefit planned for the Butler Family on Sunday February 8th. They have a Pee Wee player. There whole team will be wearing special jerseys for one game. They will also sell the extra jerseys at the fund raiser and Pee Wee tournament. A motion was made by Sally O'Borsky and seconded by Kris Holthaus to contribute \$500 to the Marie Butler Fundraising Event. This is consistent with what BYHA has done for previous situations where a BYHA family has been affected by death or serious illness. Approved 10:0.

Rink Writer: Some users feel that the system is not user friendly. The rosters can be hard to get and much information needs to be gathered by hand.

D5 Report:

Meeting attended by and reported to board by Brandon Ruiter. Full report of minutes on the D5 website. Highlights:

Sartell recently hosted an outdoor game. It went well and they would like to do more outdoor games. Payments for November scrimmages should be made quickly. CCM High Performance information is on the website. There is a reminder to parents working in the box that they need to remain impartial during the game. There is a vote pending on having EMT's at all district tournaments. The district would reimburse \$25. The actual cost is \$35 A motion was made by Brandon Ruiter and seconded by Bill McNamara that we vote yes to an EMT at the district tournaments, but that this should be done consistently throughout all associations. Approved 10:0.

BantamAA/Pee Wee AA: Coaches need to determine how they want the play-offs run. We are holding one Pee Wee and one Bantam AA game in Buffalo to determine which team advances.
