Track Wrestling online registration system cannot understand \$15 one event, \$10, 2nd event per day. Thus, it will charge \$15 each style and we'll reimburse you \$5 @ day at the 2nd style.

Admission is \$3. Use Friday ticket Saturday. Children 6 and under free. The skills academy is included in admission or entry fees.

There are four styles and a mat skills clinic. Wrestlers enter 1, 2, 3 or 4 styles or a combination at this tournament. Entrants must register online for at least one style. It is not possible to substitute one wrestler for another or a wrestler who entered one style to switch to another. The mat skills clinic is include without charge thanks to a grant from NC Amateur Sports.

It is possible for a wrestler registered in one style to add other styles at the site, paying a \$5 fee per event, plus entry. The \$5 unregistered fee is waived for wrestlers wrestling Friday who want to add a style Saturday.

*Open Division folkstyle tournaments will wrestle college rules, no headgear or uniform required. Riding time will be kept.

No contagious skin conditions allowed. Decision of tournament official or is final.

The Friday, 4:30 pm weigh in is for all styles entered. This is a single skin check weigh in for

up to 4 events per wrestler. If the only styles you enter are Saturday, you may weigh in Saturday.

Weight classes will be grouped based upon age and weight. There are no pre-published weight classes. Published divisions like Cadet or Bantam are not fixed. If your wrestler might be challenged to prove age, please bring documentation. Round Robin pairings.

Two USAW member coaches allowed in mat corner. No unregistered coaches allowed.
