



## **OMHA Program of Excellence | 2015 OHL Gold Cup Team Staff Overview**

The Ontario Minor Hockey Association (OMHA) is currently accepting staffing applications for two (2) OMHA Under 16 Teams. Positions available include Head Coach (2), Assistant Coach (2) Trainers (2) for the 2015 OHL Gold Cup in Kitchener, Ontario from May 7-10, 2015.

### **Program Overview**

The OHL Gold Cup is an annual event created to feature Ontario's top Under 16 players. This event will not only showcase Ontario's talent, but serves as an evaluation and selection process for Hockey Canada and forms part of the continuum of development through camps and competitions for players in their selection and preparation to participate in international events in the Hockey Canada Program of Excellence. The top players as identified at the OHL Gold Cup will attend Hockey Canada's Under 17 Camp where Hockey Canada staff will select players to represent Canada at the World Under 17 Challenge held annually in November. With eight teams and 160 players representing the ALLIANCE, GTHL, HNO, NOHA, ODHA and OMHA, the future of Canadian hockey is on display during the OHL Gold Cup.

### **Coach Duties**

- Coordinate and conduct all on and off ice training sessions in conjunction with team staff
- Assist with the designing of team practice plans
- Coach team in all games and practices
- Coordinate with team staff the supervision and transporting of players

### **Coach Qualifications**

- Strong hockey background in coaching
- Ability to work well with other personnel including coaches, trainers and support staff
- Must have strong interpersonal skills in order to communicate with staff, coaches, players, parents and medical personnel
- Must be NCCP certified and Speak Out (or Respect In Sport) certified
- Must be a currently active OMHA Registered Coach

### **Trainer Duties**

- Administer first aid during practices, games, and other times as necessary
- Keep records of all treatments
- Conduct pre-stretching and post-stretching sessions as necessary.
- Assist with determining of supply needs as necessary
- Report injuries to medical personnel/program staff
- Assist other trainers as necessary
- Assist with coordination and distribution of team apparel including jerseys, socks, t-shirts & shorts if necessary
- Control distribution of team supplies
- Arrange equipment and water bottles on team bench
- Attend to players' equipment needs during practices and games
- Organize the team dressing room
- Coordinate with team staff the supervision and transporting of players.

### **Trainer Qualifications**

- Must be HTCP Level 2 certified
- Must be Speak Out (or Respect In Sport) certified
- Strong minor hockey background

- Must have strong interpersonal skills in order to communicate with staff, coaches, players, parents and medical personnel
- Must be a currently active OMHA Registered Trainer
