JOB DESCRIPTIONS: LIFEGUARD

SUMMARY:

Under general supervision, ensures the safety of patrons of an aquatic facility by preventing and responding to emergencies.

MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be at least 15 years of age.
- Must hold certifications with; Red Cross Lifeguard Certification, First Aid and CPR Certified, WSI recommended but not required.
- Must be able to work weekdays, weeknights, and or weekends.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Ability to react calmly and effectively in emergency situations.
- Skill in the application of lifeguarding surveillance and rescue techniques.
- Ability to pass a pre-employment physical skills evaluation as stipulated by the department.
- Ability to prepare routine administrative paperwork.
- Knowledge of CPR and emergency medical procedures.
- Ability to follow routine verbal and written instructions.
- Knowledge of customer service standards and procedures.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Maintains constant surveillance of patrons in the facility; acts immediately and appropriately to secure safety of patrons in the event of emergency.
- 2. Provides emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services.
- 3. Presents professional appearance and attitude at all times, and maintains a high standard of customer service.
- 4. Performs various maintenance duties as directed to maintain a clean and safe facility.
- 5. Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist in daily pool maintenance such as cleaning the deck, backwashing the pool, cleaning of building facilities, vacuum pool, check and record chemicals
 as directed by pools supervisor.
- Assist in posting daily swimming schedules on board and on telephone recording system of lesson times, cancellations, and closings.
- Responsible for the security of the pool and surrounding area.
- Assist and teach swimming lessons as assigned
- Oversee all lesson tests and keep appropriate records of students
- Report any special needs to pool supervisor and attend any employee meetings calls by Pool Supervisor or Park Board.
- Report directly to the Pool Supervisor.
