

## Player Code of Conduct Agreement

Harbor Soccer Club and Harbor Premier (HSC) Players have many outstanding opportunities to play soccer at the highest competitive level and to travel. These opportunities carry with them responsibility, maturity and self-discipline. Each player must agree to adhere to the Player Code of Conduct stated below. As a player for Harbor Soccer Club, you are a representative for our club and a role model for our clubs younger players.

I agree to the following expectations for:

I will participate in all team functions as expected, including club and team fundraisers.

I will attend all practices and matches and be at meeting destination, on time, unless prior approval and arrangements were made with my coach(s) and manager.

I will exemplify the highest standards of behavior wherever I am, recognizing that I am a representative of Harbor Soccer Club.

I will refrain from any use of any harmful or illegal substances.

I will refrain from language that is offensive or inappropriate.

I will put forth my best effort in maintaining grades at the highest level possible.

I will treat my teammates, coaches, managers and chaperones with respect.

When traveling as a team member representing Harbor Soccer Club:

I agree to use common sense on trips including following the instructions of coaches, manager and chaperones.

I agree not to enter a room or let anyone enter my room that is not associated with Harbor Soccer Club and is not accompanied by a legal guardian and/or manger or chaperone of the team.

I will honor all predetermined curfew times.

I will always notify the manager or designated chaperone of my whereabouts.

I will always adhere to Rule of 3, a minimum of 3 players together when going from place to place (i.e. hotel to restaurant, field to restroom).

I understand and agree that any violations of the above applicable rules will result in a range of consequences (depending on the severity of the infraction), including, but not limited to, loss of playing time, game suspension, assignment to community service, and/or removal from the Harbor Soccer Club. The coach, may obtain counsel from the Executive Board and/or the Disciplinary review board members in determining the appropriate consequences and or sanctions.
