## Parent Code of Conduct

GYHA Bears Parent Code of Conduct: Members are subject to adhering to the Code of Conduct Rules (GYHA Bears) which the Greeley Youth Hockey Association Board of Directors has created for all parents and players. As a member of the GYHA Bears, all parents and players are expected to abide by the GYHA Bears Rules for players and parents. Failure to adhere to these rules will, at the discretion of the GYHA Bears Board, result in a scheduling of a mandatory disciplinary hearing in accordance with the Disciplinary Committee and set forth Disciplinary Action and Consequence Procedures. If you fail to appear at the hearing, repeat the offense, and/ or commit another offense, the GYHA Bears Board of Directors/Disciplinary Committee may remove you and/or your child from participating in this organization. GYHA Bears will also support any ruling made by CAHA or USA Hockey (in addition to the GYHA Board of Directors ruling) should you be called to appear before the rules and disciplinary committee of GYHA Bears.

Zero Tolerance: GYHA Bears follows the USA Hockey Zero Tolerance Policy. Any player, parent, or coach who conducts themselves in a manner found to be detrimental to the welfare of this organization may be removed from participating in this club temporarily or permanently.

GYHA Bears Parent Code of Conduct (Parent/s must read and sign below):

\* I will be supportive of our team and my child's teammates acknowledging the honest effort given by them in both win and loss scenarios. I will encourage my child to follow the player Code of Conduct and to play by the rules. I understand that I am the best example for my child of how to behave.

\* I will teach my child good sportsmanship and emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child.

\* I understand that the games are for my child, not me. Therefore, I will remember at all times the importance of skill development over my personal desire to win

\* I will avoid saying or doing anything which will hurt, degrade, or insult any player, coach, or official. I will not embarrass my child by yelling negative remarks at my child, other players, coaches, or officials during practices or games. Rather, I will maintain a positive attitude towards the game and all of its participants so that my child will benefit from his or her youth hockey experience. I will reinforce the positive points of the game and work toward removing physical and verbal abuse in youth sports.

\* I understand that I am representing Greeley Bears Hockey as well as such, my actions must be exemplary at all games, practices, travel tournaments, and anywhere else that I represent Greeley Bears Hockey.
