- Review of Try Hockey Coordinator position – Propose 15 points for managing fall and spring sessions

Position: Try Hockey Coordinator

Duties: The try hockey coordinator is responsible for the following duties:

1. Monitor the sign up process and make sure that no more than the allowed number of skaters sign up.
 2. Call each family that signed up and remind them of the details of the program during the week of the first try hockey session.
 3. Coordinate with the director of coaching on the session plans and to make sure that enough coaches are present for the sessions.
 4. Bring equipment down from the equipment room and have it available for the try hockey participants. (Breezers, gloves, elbow pads, sticks)
 5. At the end of each session, return the equipment to the equipment room.
 6. Record each participant that arrives and each person that volunteers for the try hockey sessions.
 7. Have people present on the last session to register players for x-ice or full season
 8. At the conclusion of the try hockey program, separate and organize all the equipment and place it back in the proper containers.
 9. Turn in volunteer points for the volunteers to the volunteer point coordinator.
 10. Send a thank you to the Blades players that were willing to help out with the program.

 - o Will be playing in Sioux Falls B/C tournament
 - Will hold four top Mini Mites at the current level and work to develop those players together
