Wing Hunter Ward, who averaged 15 ppg for Monroe's JV team, provides Wisconsin Hoops Select with some athleticism and slashing ability ... Milton's Mark Bowditch played on the freshman squad for the Redhawks and figures to add quality depth in the backcourt ... The front line will see contribution from Cullen Brooks of New Glarus who averaged 13 ppg for the Glarner Knight's JV team, Jadyn Ellis of Janesville Parker who saw meaningful minutes for Janesville Parker's varsity team, Hunter Patchin of McFarland who used his length to average 9 ppg for McFarland's JV team and Deron Mitchell of Madison Memorial who led the Spartans freshman team in scoring ... Coach James looks for Stoughton's Aidan McGee to bring defensive intensity in the back court this season.

Strengths (From Coach Carter James): “We will be very athletic, which will allow us to play an up tempo style on both offense and defense. This team also has very skilled shooters who also have the ability to get the ball to the basket.”

Questions (From Coach Carter James): “We only have four players returning from the 14U team last season, so the ability to mesh together will be critical to how our season goes. Getting on the same page early in the season and matching individual goals with team goals may be a challenge early on.”
