Minutes from previous meeting were approved.

Mike spoke about holding back the August college distribution of monies to give the board a chance to decide if we want to pay what we would have paid last year or a chance to adjust it when we get to that line item.

Memberships – Leave the card cost at \$35.00, \$22.00 of that will go to USA Wrestling and \$13.00 will stay with us. Coaches cards will be \$40.00, we will give USA Wrestling \$26.00 and \$14.00 will stay with us. With having 9,100 athletes and 1,900 coaches, we should net approximately \$144,00.00.

Video Revenue – We will go one more year of providing video track cast get it out there. What we paid last year for all of the video was 2,600.00. Mike would like to see advertising on track cast to cover the cost of the video's.

We have about \$370,000.00 in cash. Our income is down this year.

Kansas Colleges – Will C. made the motion to allocate 25,000.00 to colleges, excluding the KCWF expenses, Joe K. second the motion and everyone voted yes and one chose to abstain. The allocation of monies will be brought up at a later time after a letter is sent to each institute.
