Vice President Functions and Responsibilities

The Vice President's main functions are to manage the high school liaisons and the team managers. The Vice President has one vote in all matters of the Board.

Specifically, the Vice President is minimally responsible for:

- Working with the President and Hockey Director to ensure Lakers have representation at every AHAI meeting
 - Monthly AHAI meetings
 - o Illinois High School Hockey League meetings
- Serving as back up for all President responsibilities should (s)he be absent or unavailable
 - Representing Lakers in any disciplinary matters with AHAI, players and parents or opposing teams
 - Assigning tasks and responsibilities
- Supporting other members' responsibilities to assist with overflow should it be necessary
- Working with membership, potential membership and local communities to build awareness of the Lakers Hockey Club
- Serving on the Rules and Ethics committee

The Vice President shall send a request at the beginning of the season for volunteers for each of our represented high schools. High School liaisons will work with one another to schedule Lakers participation at homecoming parades, work directly with schools band/choir departments to have a student sing the National Anthem and/or the high school band play at a game. This will only be done at home games where both JV and Varsity are playing back to back games. High School liaisons will also work directly with their schools in getting the Lakers Hockey team recognized as a sport; examples—yearbook photos, social media posts, etc...

The Vice President shall send a request at the beginning of the season for volunteers for team managers. Each team is allowed two managers. The Vice President will also work directly with team managers in getting them prepared before the season begins.
