Flag football

We asked Coach Todd for his opinion

• Key to football in the 3rd grade is the coach. Good coach - no issue. However, he feels he may lose kids if they don't have a positive experience. If we don't have enough kids to play tackle, we should make sure they have the opportunity to play flag. Flag football will reduce injuries. Every kid can touch the football in flag. Feels good age for tackle is 5th grade.

Comments from board members

- Has experience that he can teach older kids how to tackle, experience is good, but not required.
- Karen is in favor with moving up the age group.
- Chad feels we could play flag in-house for earlier years and could transition to traveling. Recommends we create a board position for flag football so we have a consistent contact and response.
- David B believes we need to let society lead us.
- End of year survey for flag football had four 2nd grade parents respond, two recommended 3rd grade, two recommended higher grades.

Football Board Priorities:

High School Head Coach Todd was asked to attend the meeting and tell us what is important to him and his program and how we can better our program. This is a quick summary:

- Must do something fun each day.
- Each kid must get better each day.
- Want each kid to come out next year.
- Number one input to his priorities is the coach.
- Playing time is important. Should be able to have balanced playing time, but not balanced touches.
- Good coaching coaching is being smart with where to play kids.
- Granted everyone wants to carry the ball there is 22 positions best 11 are playing defense. Difficult job to spread the fun.
- Everybody wants to win nobody wants to get beat up and loose. Will kill a program.
- What about safety put them on offense. Put two receivers out there.

The board completed an exercise to help our board prioritize our efforts. A list of 12 or 13 items was created and then combined down to five items. An order importance was generated.

- 1. Player Safety
- 2. Positive experience
- 3. Skill Development / Character development
- 4. Player Retention/Expansion
- 5. Coach retention / Recruitment / Development
- 6. Parent Education to drive Support and Engagement
