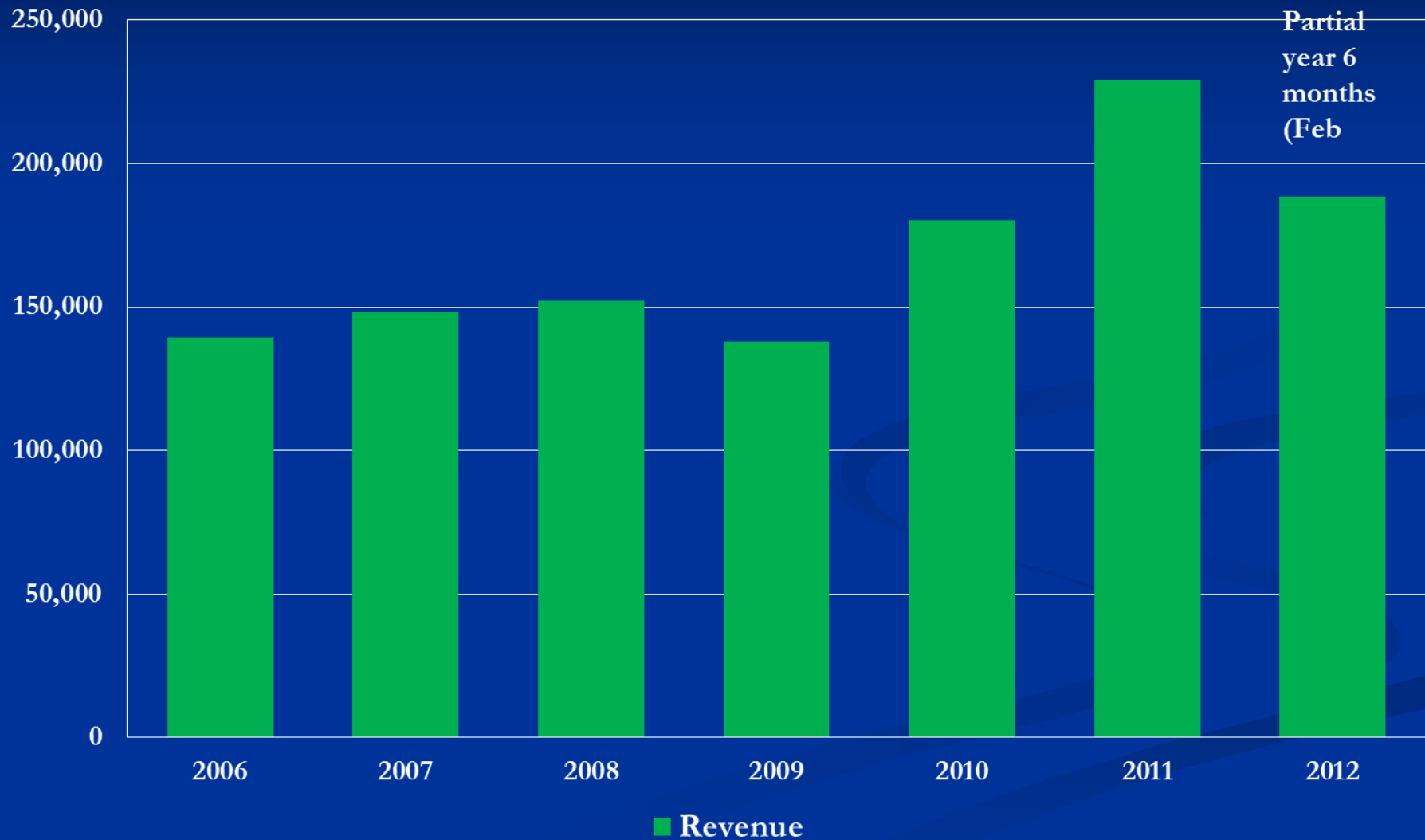

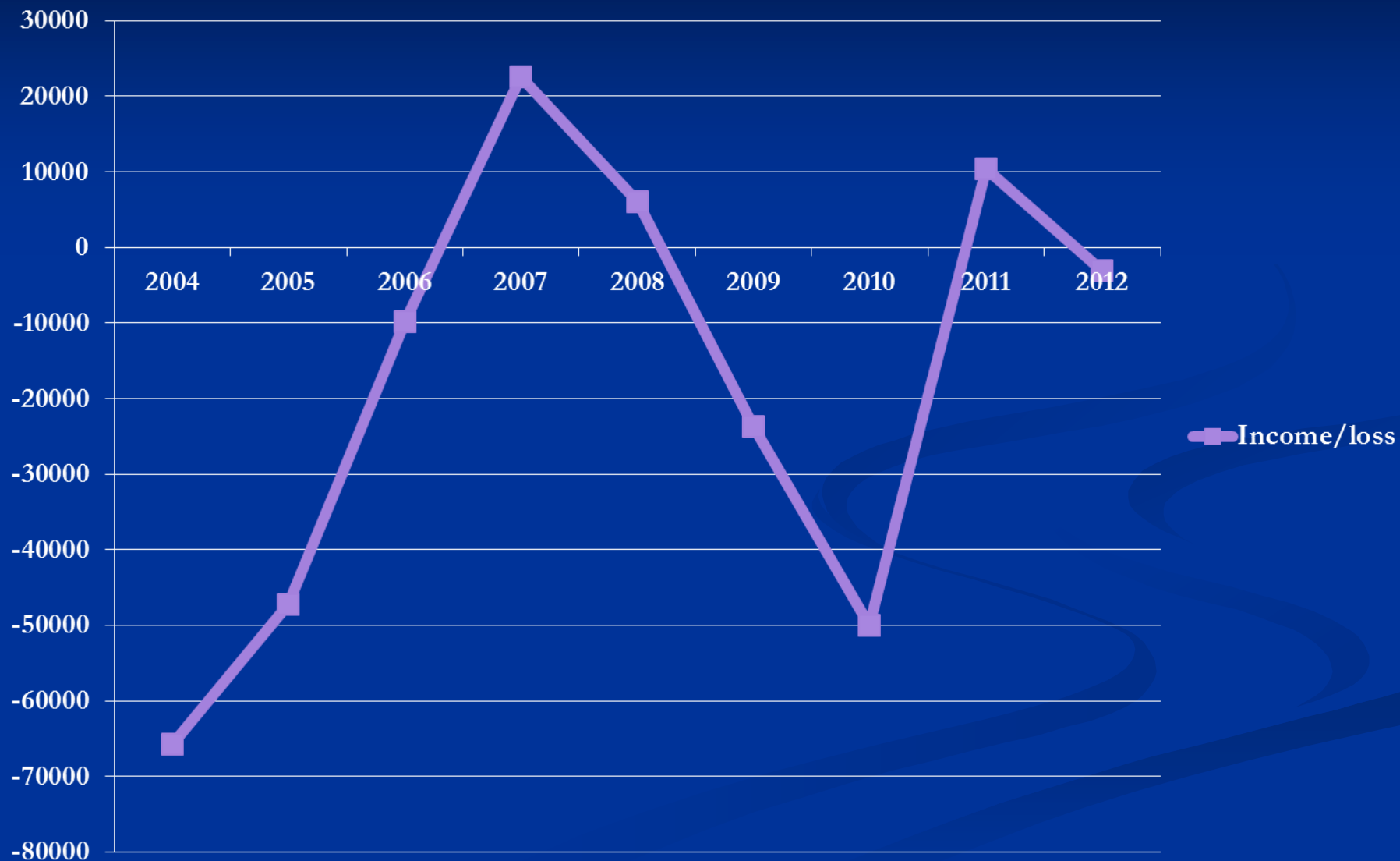
GYHA Revenue

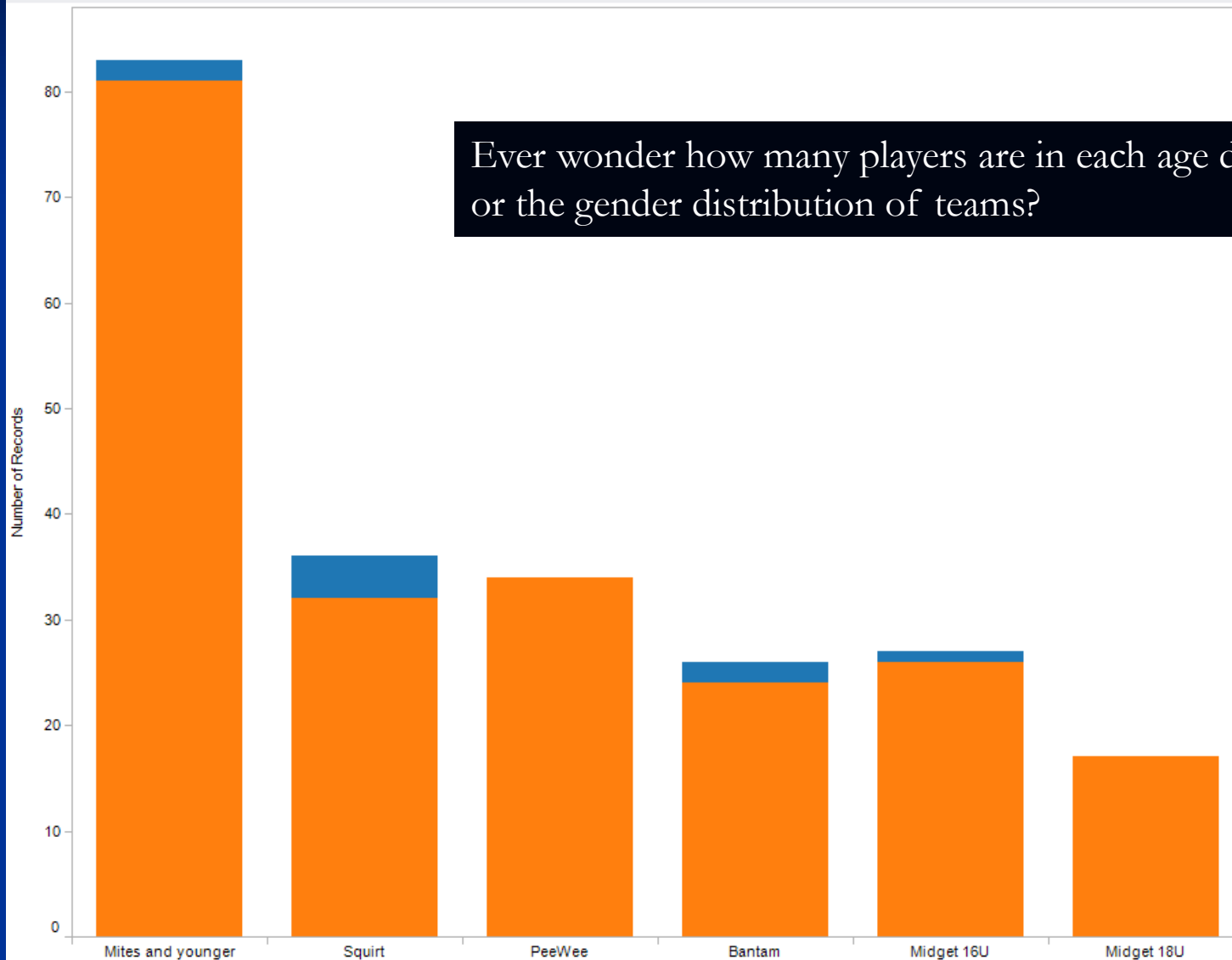

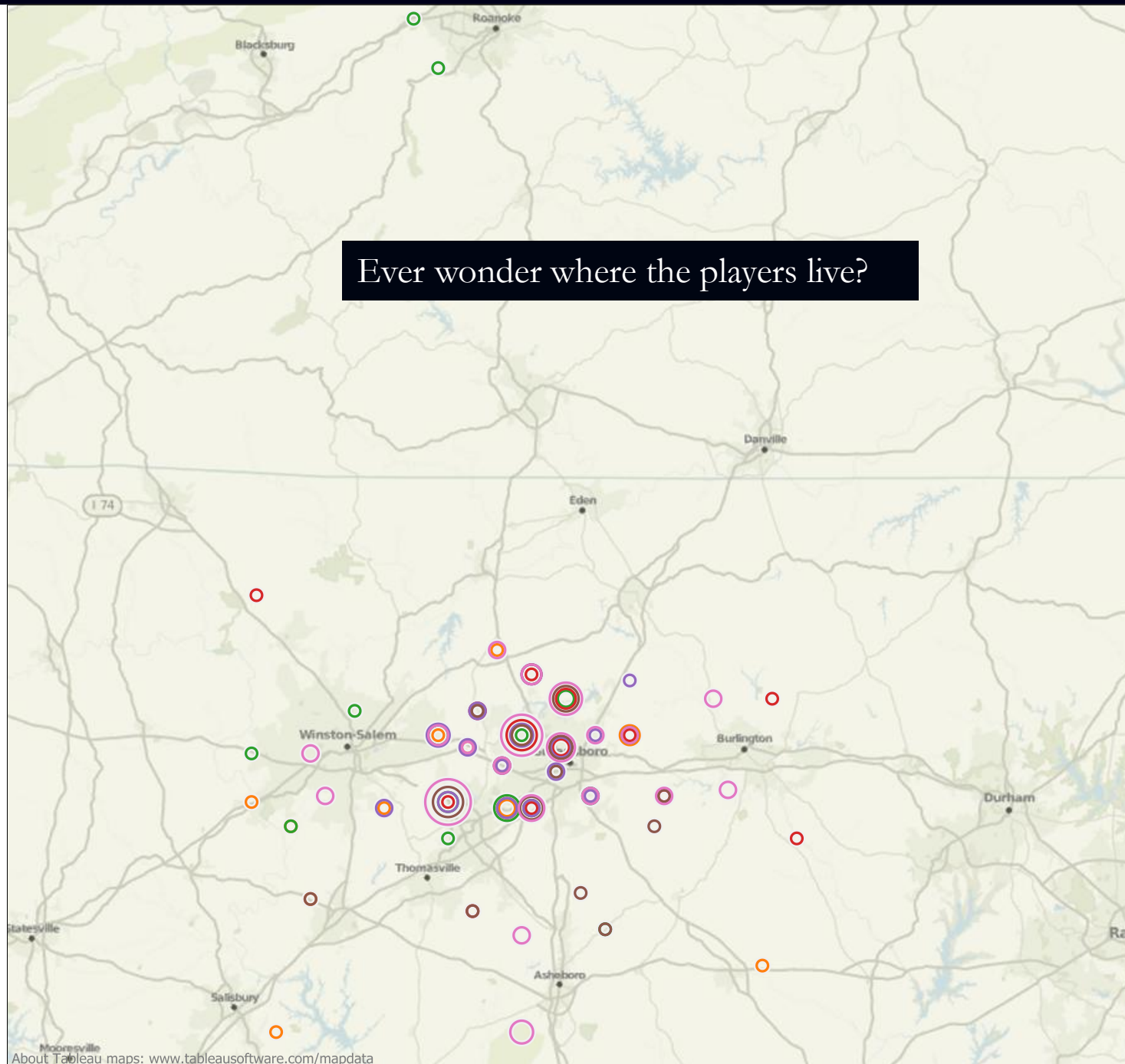

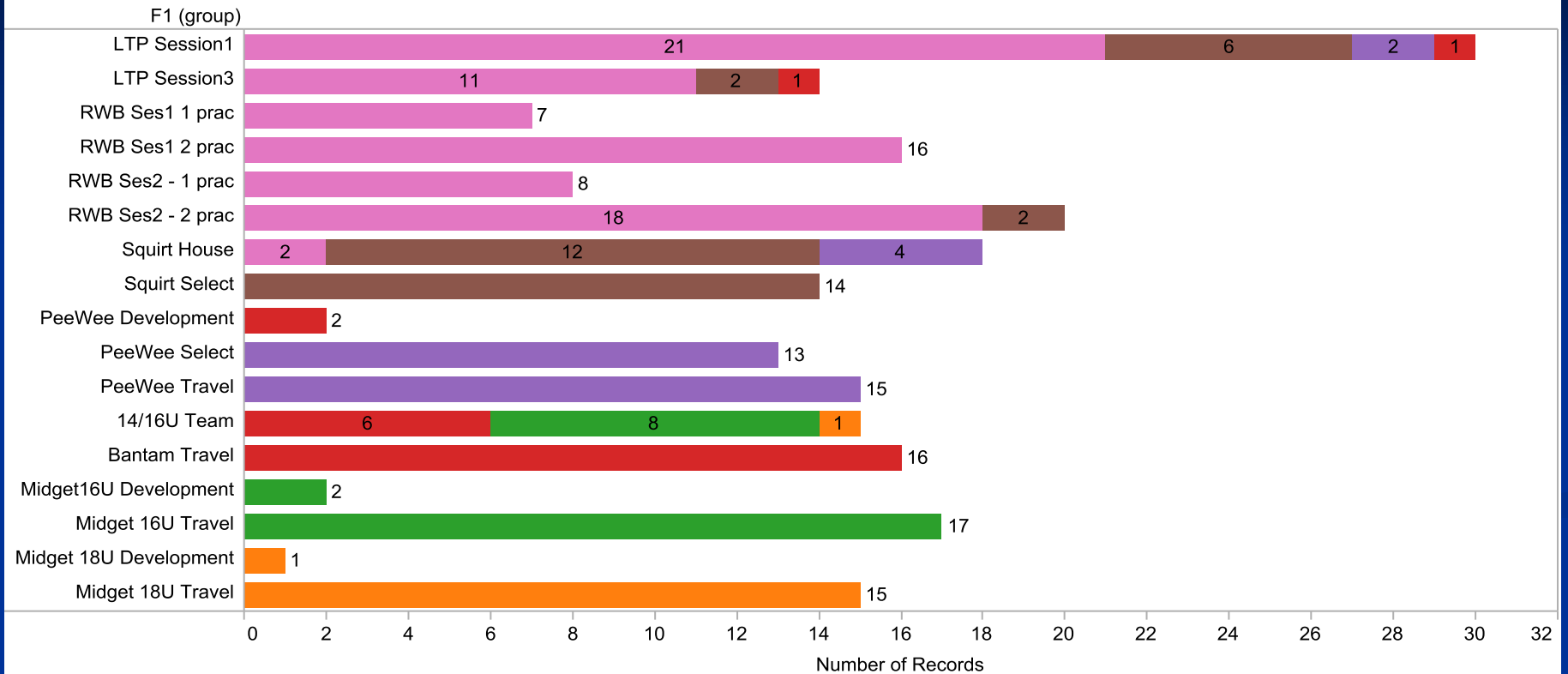
