

SPRING LAKE PARK YOUTH HOCKEY PAYMENT POLICY

Payment types

Payments are split into two categories, registration fees and season fees. Registration fees are due and payable prior to the start of the season. Season fees are due and payable by November 15, or per the schedule below, if the member so chooses:

- Mites: 50% November 15, 50% January 15.
- Traveling skaters, except 2nd year bantams: 25% November 15, 25% December 15, 25% January 15, 25% February 15.
- 2nd year bantam skaters: 33% November 15, 33% December 15, 33% January 15
- Traveling goalies: 50% November 15, 50% January 15.
- Girls in Blaine Co-op program: Pay directly to Blaine Youth Hockey Association per BYHA's policies

Exemptions

- In order to encourage young players to experience association hockey, SLPYHA waives the season fee for any mite or squirt player who has not previously played organized hockey, either through SLPYHA, another youth hockey association, or independent leagues. These players remain responsible for registration fees, volunteer commitments, and fundraising requirements as set forth by SLPYHA.
- Members in good standing who are experiencing financial hardship may apply for special consideration to extend the payment plan.
- Members in good standing who work at Fogerty concession stands with hourly wage paid directly to SLPYHA will be considered for extensions.

Interest and Penalties

SLPYHA offers the payment plans interest free to its members in good standing. Late fees, in the amount of 2% of the outstanding balance, will be assessed for payments not made by the due date. Checks returned unpaid for any reason will be assessed a \$25 handling fee.

Collections

Any member accounts with unpaid balances as of May 1 will be turned over to third party collections.
