The Montana Army National Guard is committed to recognizing academic achievements by our student activity participants on the team level. The MHSА has been very pleased with the opportunity for schools to be recognized for all their student activities participants' academic achievement through the NorthWestern Energy's Academic Excellence Awards. Also, the Montana Coaches Association recognizes individual academic achievement through their Academic All State Program. The MTARNG Academic All-Team Program recognizes teams for their academic achievement.

The Montana High School Association is proud to be partnered with the Montana Army National Guard to provide this valuable program for our 181 member schools. With Montana Army National Guard's support and dedication, members of high school teams will be recognized for their academic achievements. The MHSА is dedicated to making sure academics are a priority, and the Montana Army National Guard helps sponsor those efforts.

The MTARNG/MHSА partnership has been well-established, and the academic recognitions will continue, but the format has been revised to help renew an emphasis on this unique program. Because of the low percentage of teams previously nominated in swimming, golf, tennis and spirit, MTARNG started focusing on the following sports beginning in 2014-2015 and will select a varsity team champion in each classification: football, volleyball, girls' and boys' cross country, girls' and boys' soccer, girls' and boys' basketball, wrestling, softball and girls' and boys' track/field.

Attached is information regarding the program, including G.P.A. Guidelines, Participant Criteria, Reporting Requirements and the Winter Activity Season Reporting Form. **ARMY NATIONAL GUARD
ACADEMIC ALL TEAM AWARD**

WINTER SEASON ACTIVITY TEAMS

The MHSA/Army National Guard Academic All Team Award is given to the top team in each classification that exhibits outstanding academic achievement during the school year's second quarter of play for that activity. One **VARSITY TEAM** in each classification (AA, A, B and C) will be awarded (unless otherwise specified).

The following criteria shall be utilized by MHSA member schools to calculate their students' accumulative average for the award. This form should be used only for students who have participated in second quarter activities including Boys' Basketball, Girls' Basketball and Wrestling.

A. G.P.A. Guidelines

1. The G.P.A. shall be based on a 4.0 system using this school's year second quarter grades.
2. The G.P.A. shall follow Article II, Section (2) of the MHSA Handbook.
3. All second quarter classes which award credit and which are graded shall be included for each student's G.P.A.
4. The total team's G.P.A. must be calculated to the nearest thousandth.

B. Participants

1. All students (not including managers or statisticians) who participated in boys' basketball, girls' basketball or wrestling and **earned a varsity letter** shall be used. (Average for students enrolled in Special Education shall not be included).
2. To be considered a "team" there must be adequate numbers of eligible members to participate and/or to score as a team in an Association contest.

C. Reporting Requirements

1. Schools determine which teams' G.P.A.'s will be submitted. Participating schools are not required to submit data on each team or for each sport.
2. Any and all submissions for each school should be submitted on one form.
3. Activities/Athletics Directors must sign the reporting form to be sent to the MHSA office.
4. The worksheets for calculating each team's G.P.A. should be kept by the school for reference purposes and should be available upon request.
5. If schools cooperatively sponsor an activity, all students that participate on the school's co-op team are considered part of that team with the host school reporting the team members.
6. The application must be submitted to the MHSA office by March 9, 2020.
