## **Meeting Minutes**

**Previous minutes from April:** Reviewed minutes from August 27, 2014 board meeting – no corrections or changes

**Uniforms** – We need uniforms for 4<sup>th</sup> grade boys. The ones we have are too big. Current estimate is 30 uniforms would be needed for this group. We will wait to order until registrations are completed.

**Volunteers** – update from Shawn on how other clubs handle student volunteers. Some clubs pay hourly to the students that volunteer. Concern that this would make the students employees which we want to avoid. Some clubs donate to the varsity program like we currently do. It is really all over the board on how this is handled by other clubs. It was suggested that we give  $\frac{1}{2}$  the money to the program and use  $\frac{1}{2}$  to purchase gift cards.
