

Financial Aid Policy (2023)

The Centennial Basketball Association (CBA) strives to create a positive, fun environment for boys and girls to develop basketball skills, promote teamwork and instill in them the principles of sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, courage and respect.

The purpose of CBA Financial Aid is to make it economically possible for players to participate in our programs. To be eligible, players must qualify for the free and/or reduced price school lunch program. Proof of participation in this program is required.

**The Financial Aid application is due:
August 25, 2023 for TRAVELING
September 30, 2023 for IN-HOUSE
NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED**

Financial Aid amounts will be based on the number of applications received. Maximum Financial Aid amounts will be as follows:

- Up to 100% of the cost of in-house registration (~\$180) for free lunch (for both the traveling and in-house programs).
- Up to 75% of the cost of in-house registration (~\$135) for reduced lunch (for both the traveling and in-house programs).

Information provided by you on the form is strictly confidential and will only be shared with those involved in the financial aid decision making process, including school officials to verify eligibility.

- Applicants must be a resident of the Centennial High School attendance boundary or attend a Centennial school to apply.
- Applicants and their families are expected to pay a portion of the traveling fees (see Financial Aid policy for details)
- Applicants and their families are expected to pay a minimum of the uniform costs (\$10.00 for in-house participants and \$136 for traveling uniform)
- Financial Aid will be awarded based on a demonstrated financial need.

- Application and proof of participation in the lunch program must be received prior to deadline.

NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Once the application and lunch information is received the CBA Financial Aid committee (In-House Administrator, Treasurer, and Registrar) will review all applications. Applicants will be notified of the Financial Aid amount awarded within one week of the deadline. A registration discount code will be provided if approved.
