

MFEA Scholarship Application: General Guidelines

Eligibility:

- a) Applicant must be a graduating senior who has competed in Montana Forensics for at least three years.
- b) Scholarships up to \$500 will be awarded following the spring coaches meeting.

Application Must Include:

- a) Cover sheet
- b) Two letters of recommendation, one of which comes from your coach.
- c) A current transcript.
- d) A letter of intent (maximum of 1 typed page, 12-pt Times or Arial, double-spaced, 1" margins). This letter should answer the following question: How will the skills you acquired in Speech, Debate and Drama benefit you in your future career?
- e) Provide an educational resume (personal data sheet) including: GPA and grading scale; a list of honors, activities, community service or volunteer work; job experience which may be applicable; and an account of Forensics achievements.

Selection Criteria:

- a) Application required by March 1st
- b) Awards will be determined from acceptable applications at the discretion of the standing Forensics Scholarship Committee.
