

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULING PROTOCOL

In order to provide the most up-to-date information about power soccer competition in the USA, the USPSA requests that you notify us about any upcoming tournaments you wish to host. By doing this, you will help the USPSA keep track of competitions, assist us in effectively informing the membership of playing opportunities, and avoid scheduling conflicts.

PRIOR TO POSTING ONLINE OR SENDING OUT EMAILS, PLEASE...

Check the USPSA website for the current tournament schedule. Then email, call or fax the USPSA Secretary to let them know of your potential dates. The USPSA Secretary will check all tournaments, including those that have not yet been posted on the website, and advise you of conflicts.

If there are no conflicts, then complete this "**Tournament Scheduling Form**" available on the USPSA website and fax, email or mail it to the USPSA IT committee chairperson.

The USPSA Secretary and IT Committee will use this form to post your tournament information on the USPSA website. To be listed on the website, tournament games must be between USPSA member teams in good standing, played by current USPSA rules, and officiated by USPSA approved referees. Only games that meet these requirements are considered "USPSA sanctioned" games and count in a team's record and towards the number of games needed to qualify for a Conference Cup.

During your tournament, please fill out official score sheets (available as PDF) and the electronic score and stat sheet (Excel file) and submit to the USPSA Secretary at the conclusion of all games. These files are available for download at: http://www.powersoccerusa.net/downloads.

Note: Conference Cups are scheduled by the Tournament Selection Committee. To bid to host a Conference Cup, see the Conference Cup Bid Packet available online.
