# Quarterback Club Scholarship

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to senior football players planning on attending an accredited post-secondary institution

#### **ELIGIBILITY**:

- 1. Candidate must be a senior who will be attending an accredited post-secondary institution the year following high school graduation.
- 2. Candidate must have participated as a high school football during their senior year.
- 3. Candidate must not have engaged in actions or behavior detrimental to the advancement of the football program.

#### CANDIDATE SHOULD DEMONSTRATE:

- 1. Volunteerism through community involvement.
- 2. A sense of leadership, teamwork and positive attitude.
- 3. A contribution to the development and/or participation in the youth football program.
- 4. \*Recommendations from members of the community (1-2 non-family) highlighting the above criteria.

#### SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA:

Applications and recommendations are reviewed by at least 5 reviewers comprised of board members of the Quarterback Club (with no conflict of interest), plus one or more members of the Youth Tackle Football Association, Quarterback Club membership or other (i.e. teachers, other community leaders.)

#### **DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS:**


The Quarterback Club will distribute the scholarship money once the student has met the following criteria:

- 1. Proof of successful completion of one term.
- 2. Proof of registration for a second term.
- 3. Student must have a 2.5 GPA or better for their first term

### Quarterback Club Scholarship

Scholarships available to a Senior Football Player planning to obtain a 4-year Bachelor's degree.

#### AWARD:

1. The Quarterback Club will grant two scholarships, each in the amount of \$1,000.

#### TO QUALIFY:

- 1. The candidate must be a senior who will be attending a 4-year college.
- 2. Eligible candidates must have been a High School Football Player and participated their senior year.
- 3. Candidate must not have engaged in actions or behavior detrimental to the advancement of the program, whether or not it resulted in disciplinary action.
- 4. Candidate must have maintained a 3.0 GPA during High School.

#### **KEY FACTORS FOR CONSIDERATION:**

1. Preference will be given to those football players who exhibit the following attributes: Positive Attitude, Leadership, and Citizenship, contributed to the development and/or participated in the youth football program(s).

#### **SELECTION PROCESS:**

Board members of the Quarterback Club, with no conflict of interests. Plus one or more members of the Youth Tackle Football Association, Quarterback Club membership or other (i.e. teachers, Booster Club or Sports Association members). A total of 5 reviewers will be part of the selection process.

#### **DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS:**

The Quarterback Club will distribute the scholarship money once the student has met the following criteria:

- 1. Proof of successful completion of one term.
- 2. Proof of registration for a second term.
- 3. Student must have a 2.5 GPA or better.

#### APPLICATION DEADLINE:

The deadline for application submission is 3-3-15.
