Team information section including Coach, Manager, and Score fields for both teams: ARL White/Unicorns 13G (TXN) and ARL Jones/Crush 12G (TXN).

Two 'Frozen Event Roster' tables, one for each team. Each table has columns for ID, #, Name, checkmark, DOB, Yellow Card, and Red Card. The first team's roster lists seven players named Susie Smith with various DOBs.

Goalkeeping and team color sections. Includes 'Home Goals' and 'Away Goals' tables with columns for By #, Min., and Final Score. Also includes 'Team Colors' (yellow for home, orange for away) and 'Home/Away Official Sign' fields.

Referees table with columns for Referees, Grade, USSF ID Number, and Instructions/Notes. Includes a reminder for 9U-19U to enter scores within a timely manner.

Cautionable and Sending-Off Offense Codes table. Lists codes such as UB (Unsporting Behavior), DT (Dissent by word or action), PI (Persistent infringement), DR (Delays restart of play), FRD (Fails to respect required distance), L (Leaves the field without permission), E (Enters the field without permission), SFP (Serious foul play), VC (Violent conduct), AL (Offensive, insulting, or abusive language), DGH (Denies opposing team of obvious goal-scoring opportunity), and DGF (Denies obvious goal-scoring opportunity to an opponent).

Game Sheet

YOU MUST HAVE A GAME SHEET FOR EVERY GAME

Print them from your GotSoccer team account.

If you forget your game sheet, there are blank forms available in the green barn at the fields.

4U-8U will keep game sheets so a manager/parent can check off the opposing players at the start of each quarter. Give the game sheet to the referee at the end of the game.

Game Day

4U 6 Minute Quarters
5U/6U 8 Minute Quarters
7U/8U 10 Minute Quarters

EVERY PLAYER MUST PLAY 50% OF EVERY GAME.

If a player is missing, line through their name.

If a player gets sick/hurt and can't continue, make a note on the gamesheet.

Do not write in the misconduct section as this is for the referees.

Home team provides the ball for the game.

4U-8U The home team sits on the North or West side of the field.

Please be considerate of your opponent and DO NOT run up the score.

Touchline Behavior

COACHES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR HIS/HER TOUCHLINE.

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP YOUR SIDELINE CALM.

IF A COACH, SPECTATOR OR PLAYER IS SENT AWAY FROM THE FIELD, THAT PERSON MUST SIT OUT THE NEXT GAME AND A SIT OUT VERIFICATION MUST BE COMPLETED.

IF COACHES OR SPECTATORS ARE GIVEN A RED CARD, THEY MUST LEAVE THE COMPLEX IMMEDIATELY.


