Online registration will be available on www.zone4.com. Registration will cost \$50 and remain open until Thursday July 13th at 11:59PM. All racers must hold valid ABA/UCI licenses or purchase a Single Event Licenses at a cost of \$10.

Racers must indicate all races they plan to participate in when registering for the event. Start lists will be prepared prior to the event to better organize the race days.

- For the Keirin there must be at least eight riders to run a qualifier.

- For the Sprint competition there must be eight riders to contest the quarterfinal, and four riders to contest the semifinal.

***There must be at least four teams registered to run the Madison*

Approximate start times will be posted at cbtl.ca on Friday evening (July 14th) for all events. Times will be subject to delays due to weather or unforeseen issues.

Equipment & Regulations:

This event will be run in accordance to ABA/CCC/UCI Cycling regulations. Riders are responsible for knowing and understanding these regulations. They can be found online [here](#). As is commonly not practiced, there will be no inspection of Junior and U17 gears.

Anti-Doping

The ABA complies with and fully supports the UCI anti-doping regulations, the clauses of the World Anti-doping Code and its international Standards to which the UCI anti-doping regulations refer and to the anti-doping regulations of other competent bodies per the regulations of the UCI.

Awards

Prizes will be given to the omnium podium in each category. Racers must start each omnium event to be eligible. The Madison will be run as a stand-alone event for those riders wishing to participate.

Omnium points shall be awarded to 6th position: 10, 7, 5, 3, 2, 1. Omnium ties shall be broken according to the following tie breaking procedure:

1. Number of first place finishes. If still tied;
2. Number of second place finishes. If still tied;
3. Number of third place finishes. If still tied;
4. Result versus tied opponent in the final event in which both riders competed.

Food:

Lunch will be provided for the riders on Sunday after the completion of the last event.
