Tournament Format:

Each team is guaranteed 4 matches.

Tournament Format—Best 2 of 3 Round Robin:

1. Pius XI
2. Wilmot
3. Luther Prep

4. Union Grove
5. Shoreland Lutheran

** Each round will consist of a best 2 out of 3 match to 25 with no cap. The 3rd set will only be played, if needed, and will be to 15 with no cap.

** 1st round warm ups will follow a normal 6, 7, 7; 2nd round warm up will be 6, 7, 3; 3rd through 5th round warm ups will be 3, 3 or faster if the coaches agree.

** Each round will immediately follow the match before it.

** There will be a 20 minute lunch break after Round 3.

** Tournament Champion will be the team with the best match record following the Round Robin.

** Tie breaking procedure:

- 1) Head-to-Head
- 2) Overall Set Win %
- 3) Head-to-Head Points Allowed
- 4) Total Points Allowed
- 5) Coin Flip

** Individual medals will be given out to the 1st place team.
