Travis mentioned this is our second largest fundraiser. Marie emphasized we need golfers. Marie asked that flyers and posters be distributed and that the event be shared on social media by all attending. Players can now register online as seen on the FM Jags Baseball website. Cost per golfer is \$150. We pay Tour 18 \$65 for each golfer. Marie said we also need raffle prizes. Marie also needs volunteers for the tournament.
