



OYHA NON-PARENT COACH POLICY

Non-Parent Coach Policy:

The Ozaukee Youth Hockey Association (OYHA) sincerely thanks you for coaching and teaching our young hockey players this next season. We also appreciate all of your time, effort and expense it takes to coach youth hockey.

It is our intent to make your coaching here the best possible experience and we are excited about the upcoming season!

Rules & Expectations:

As with any youth sports we expect our players, parents and coaches to adhere to all OYHA Policies and Code of Conduct as well as any other policies or rules that protect everyone involved and create a safe environment.

By accepting a coaching position here at OYHA you accept ALL policies that are in place and agree to adhere to all of them:

- Coaching Code of Conduct (This includes on and off ice and anytime with any player, parent, referee, rink employees including restaurants, hotels, tournaments, etc.)
- USA Certification – must attend all Clinics and Online Modules required for level of coaching
- Safesport
- Background Check/Screening for all Coaches, Managers and Board Members
- OYHA Double Roster & Play Up Policy
- OYHA Game & Tournament Limit Policy

Compensation & Reimbursement:

Non-parent coaches at OYHA are generally volunteer positions, but OYHA will compensate for the following acceptable expenses:

- USA Hockey Coaching Registration expenses
- All USA Coaching Certification Clinics and Online Modules required for the level needed to coach that season only. (Example: OYHA will not pay for a level 4 coaching cert. if you only need a level 3 that season).
- Hotel, meal, and travel for out-of-town (greater than 90 minutes from Ozaukee Ice Center) tournaments. Receipts must be submitted and alcohol will not be reimbursed.

Reimbursement is for non-parent Head Coaches only. If the head coach chooses to bring in non-parent assistant coaches, OYHA may not be able to reimburse their expenses.
