



PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT



Huntington Beach Girls Softball (HBGS) seeks to ensure that all league activities are fair, positive and enjoyable experiences for all children and adults involved.

The goal is to assure that its members maintain the highest standard of sportsmanship and ethical behavior at all times. HBGS will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, marital status, gender, sexual orientation or disability.

All HBGS players, Managers/Coaches, and Parents/Spectators shall abstain from the following activities:

- a. Foul, obscene or profane language
- b. Indecent gestures
- c. Fighting
- d. Umpire abuse of any type
- e. Substance abuse (including alcohol)
- f. Bringing animals/pets to any practice/game (even on a leash/lap/cage) at fields that don't allow them. (All school sites)
- g. Tobacco use at any practice/game (smoking, vaping, chewing included)
- h. Object throwing in anger
- i. Showing disrespect to school employees and neighbors
- j. Showing disrespect or arguing with Managers/Coaches
- k. Playing of any music or speakers at Circle View School before 10am.
- l. Arguing with or harassment of opposing team's players, Managers/Coaches or parents/spectators

Players. Reminder: All players are representing HBGS at all times. All players shall be courteous to HBGS volunteers and listen to their Manager/Coach and follow the team guidelines at all times. All players will be respectful of Umpires calls and will keep all comments/objections to themselves. All players will be on time and remain for the duration of practices/games and come prepared with their equipment, appropriate beverages and attire (jacket/sweats if necessary).

Parents. All parents will help in field set up/take down as well as picking up litter after practices/games and be courteous to the "neighbors" of HBGS. No driving/parking on the Circle View blacktop is allowed. All parents/spectators will applaud good plays by both teams. All parents/spectators shall accept and not question during a game the Managers/Coaches decision concerning their child's playing position and the amount of time their child will play in any game or tournament. All Parents will follow rules posted or advised for any fields they are visiting. Parents will wait 72 hours after a game to question coaching decisions.

Spectators: All spectators shall be courteous to HBGS volunteers/players/opponents at all times. Parents of players will ensure their guests are never out of line. All Spectators will follow rules posted or advised for any fields they are visiting. Spectators will not bring dogs on/off leash to Circle View.

Managers/Coaches. All Managers/Coaches will abide by the Code of Conduct agreement that addresses their commitment to the players and the organization; and their conduct during practices, games, with umpires and off the field.

Procedure to Address Violations. All incidents shall be reported to the respective Division Commissioner, Code of Conduct Director or Player Agent. After investigation and review by the President, Vice President, Player Agent, Code of Conduct Director, respective Division Commissioner and UIC (if applicable), you may review our website for the list of sanctions will be imposed for violations.
